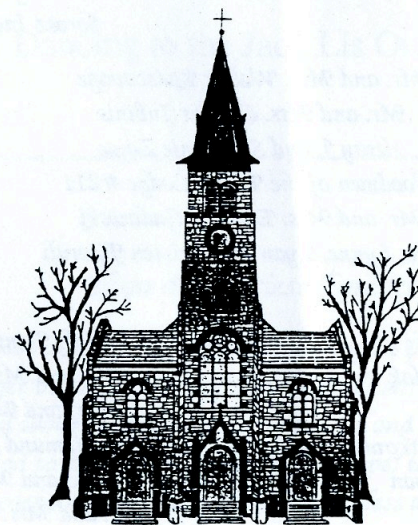

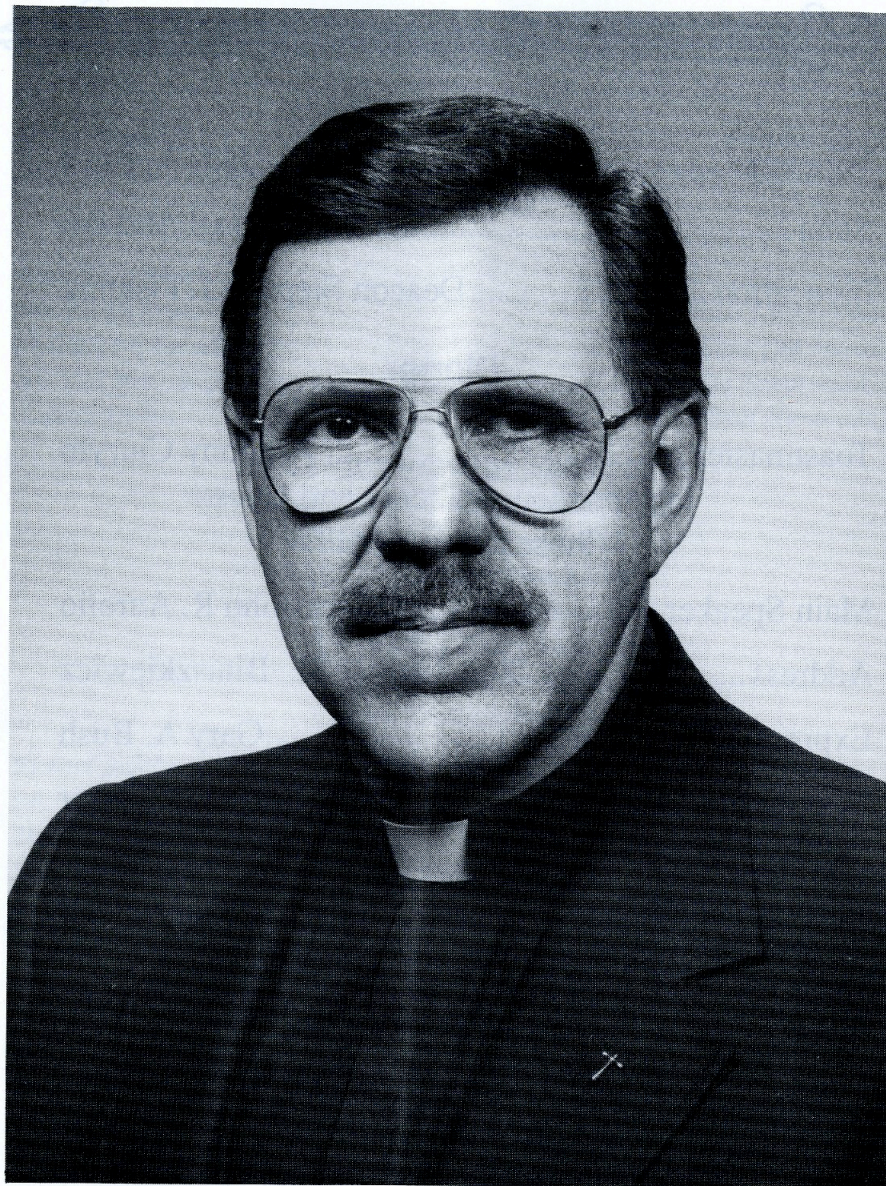

Rev. Leonard E. Biniskiewicz, the son of the late Leonard and Helen (Korzieniewski) Biniskiewicz, is a native of Buffalo as are his two sisters Mrs. Michael (Ann) Kosowski and Mrs. Stanley (Patricia) Motyka.

He attended St. Casimir's, Buffalo, St. Michael's, Lackawanna and St. Stanislaus, Buffalo, Elementary Schools. High school freshmen year was spent at the Diocesan Preparatory Seminary, sophomore year at Bishop Ryan High School and junior-senior years at Buffalo East High School. His

collegiate years were at St. Mary's Orchard Lake, Diocesan Preparatory Seminary, Christ the King Seminary in Olean and the former St. John Vianney Seminary, East Aurora. He holds a B.A. and M.S. in Education from Canisius College.

Rev. Biniskiewicz was ordained on March 9, 1963 at St. Joseph's New Cathedral, Buffalo, by Bishop Leo R. Smith. He celebrated his first Mass on March 17, 1963 at Queen of the Martyrs Church, Cheektowaga.

Following Ordination, he was assigned administrator of St. Isidore, East Otto and associate pastor of St. Florian and St. Lawrence parishes in Buffalo. He also taught, and was administrator at Bishop Turner High School, Buffalo, and Baker-Victory High School, Lackawanna. He was associate pastor of St. Catherine of Sienna, West Seneca for seven and one half years prior to his becoming pastor of Holy Trinity Parish, Niagara Falls. His appointment as pastor of Holy Trinity in 1982 by Bishop Edward D. Head was began on June 12, 1982.

Rev. Biniskiewicz is currently active in Charismatic Renewal, Cursillo and various Renewal movements in the Buffalo Diocese. He leads the Regional Prayer Meeting at Sacred Heart Church, Niagara Falls and is district coordinator of Region 26 of the Diocese of Buffalo. Active in the Renew Program for Region 26, Reverend Biniskiewicz was instrumental in the Renew Closing Celebration "Mass of Christian Unity" held at the Niagara Falls Convention Center on November 3, 1987.

Since assuming his pastorate at Holy Trinity, Rev. Biniskiewicz has instituted many changes and is constantly working toward a more active spiritual involvement of the congregation and community. Among the many changes were the establishment of:

- Ministry to the Sick
- Eucharistic Ministers
- Finance Committee
- Holy Trinity Seniors
- Tradition of decorating the "Family Christmas Tree"
- St. Vincent de Paul Society
- Lector Program
- Liturgy Committee
- Lenten Journey

In 1984-85, Rev. Biniskiewicz initiated the project of redecorating and improving parish buildings. Renovation of the Cemetery Chapel was begun in 1987. The newly decorated chapel, called the "Lord of Life Chapel", was blessed at the celebration of Mass on September 7, 1987. In February 1988, he brought the "Mission Renewal" program to the parish.

Rev. Biniskiewicz's accomplishments, and his love for mankind, are evident in all activities in which he becomes involved.
