Lord is upon me

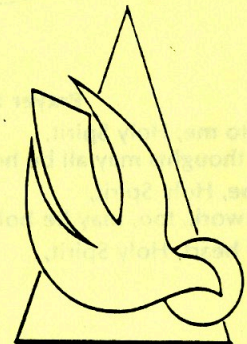
