AIDS Community Services is fighting the AIDS epidemic on four fronts:

Services to People with AIDS

AIDS Community Services provides comprehensive support services to people with AIDS, HIV, their families, and friends. These services include: case management, short term counseling, support groups, chemical dependency assessment and referral, "buddy" program, "Second Helpings" home delivered meals, and limited financial assistance. We also make referrals for housing, medical care, legal, spiritual, and financial needs.

AIDS Education and Outreach

Our education programs focus on HIV information, prevention, and risk reduction. We offer presentations tailored to suit specific audiences. AIDS Community Services operates the AIDS information and Referral Line, 716.847.AIDS. Outreach programs include Street Outreach to substance users and their partners, and adolescents at high risk.

Suggestions for AIDS Walk '95

Before the Walk. Sign up as many sponsors as you can – your friends, family members, coworkers and neighbors. You'll be surprised at the generosity of those around you. Set a goal for yourself to raise at least \$100. Ask each sponsor for at least two dollars per mile (\$10) or for as much as possible. Anyone who brings \$100 in pre–paid pledges to the Walk will receive a distinctive AIDS Walk '95 t-shirt by renowned artist Philip Burke.

Encourage your friends and family to join you in AIDS Walk "95. Or team up to fight AIDS – organize your co-workers, bridge club, social group, school or congregation. Carry a banner. Get t-shirts printed with your organization's name on them. For more information about forming a team, call the AIDS Walk '95 office. Step to the head of the Walk as a corporate sponsor and show your company's commitment to the fight against AIDS. For details of sponsorship benefits and how your company can participate, call the AIDS Walk '95 office.

Ask your sponsors to pay when they pledge. This will speed the money to reach people whose lives are touched by AIDS in Western New York and will avoid making a second visit to each sponsor to collect money. Ask sponsors to pay with a check payable to AIDS Community Services. Their cancelled check is their receipt. If they need an additional receipt, they may contact the AIDS Walk '95 office.

Walk Day Sunday, June 4th. Bring the sponsor form and all prepaid pledges with you to the Walk Registration Center at Niagara Square. Before assembling to walk, please sign in, and turn in your pledges. If you have all your pledges you will also turn in your sponsor form. If not, you may keep your sponsor form until all pledges have been collected. **Registration begins at 10 am. The Walk will begin at 11 am.** Since hundreds of people will be participating, we suggest you arrive promptly at 10 am.

Most people will walk 5 miles in two hours. With the unpredictability of Buffalo weather, it's a good idea to dress comfortably in layers, so as you get warmer, you can remove layers and maintain your energy. Sturdy shoes are also recommended.

Delicious snacks and water will be provided, as well as a post walk celebration at the finish. Restroom facilities will be provided along the route. Municipal Code prohibits the consumption and possession of open containers of alcoholic beverages in public places. This includes the Walk route and Niagara Square.

Rain or Shine. Even if it rains, come to the Walk and register at 10 am and turn in your pledges and sponsor form. If hazardous weather forces the cancellation of the Walk, you will be credited 5 miles by AIDS Walk staff and asked to send in all outstanding pledges.

After the Walk. After the Walk, please collect any pledges that were not paid and mail them as soon as possible to:
