

Church History

The Hopewell Baptist Church was organized in the home of Rev. John F.D. Lyles,

in January of 1956 at 474 Genesee st.

The church was organized with eight members and we are still blessed to have two remaining charter members with us today.

They are Mother Marguerite Dunford and Mother Gladys Bonner.

Due to our constant growth we have moved several times starting at 474 Genesee Street to our present location, 1307 Fillmore Avenue. In the near future, we are planning on one more move which will be our new edifice.

Our founder and pastor, Rev. John F. D. Lyles, served faithfully until his death, December 8, 1987.

In June of 1988, Dennis Lee, Jr. was called to be our pastor. Under his leadership and the vision that the Lord has given him, we have continued to grow spiritually.

Under Pastor Lee's leadership we have established a "Nurse's Guild, a Board of Christian Education, a Youth, Women's and Men's Ministry, a week of Vacation Bible

School, and on Wednesday nights our bible study has grown to three separate classes.
