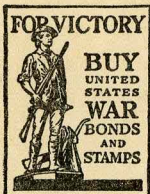
This Reemployment Committee has been advised of your separation from active duty with the Armed Forces and we are writing to welcome you home and offer such assistance as you may desire in returning to civilian life.

The Selective Service System is responsible under the Selective Training and Service Act of 1940, as amended, for rendering re-employment or employment assistance to all veterans who have satisfactorily completed service. The Selective Service System will also furnish information and assistance having to do with benefits available under the G. I. Bill and other Federal or State legislation.

You are cordially invited to call at the office of this Re-employment committee or at any Selective Service Local Board Office which is more accessible to your present address. No fees or charges are involved. The only necessary action is your request for assistance or information.

Kindly permit us to convey this word of warning to veterans interested in seeking re-employment. Your application for reinstatement in the job you had at the time you entered the Armed Forces must be made within 90 days from the date of separation from active military service or within 90 days from the date of release from hospitalization resulting from service connected disability.
