
OBITUARY

Dr. S. Calvin Johnson, son of Reverend Alexander Johnson and Sina Nettie Johnson was born February 16, 1902, Sumpter, South Carolina. As his Dad did before him, he graduated from Johnson C. Smith University. He received his Medical Doctor Degree from Meharry Medical College, Nashville, Tennessee, 1931. He was Founder and Director of a Community Medical Clinic in Lackawanna, New York (1932 - 1937); Consultant and Clinician Buffalo Planned Parenthood Association (1942 - 1960). He established a private medical practice covering 55 years. He is a charter member of Upstate Medical Alliance (1941). His creativity was expressed in several oil paintings. Penned numerous poems on the quality of life. His legacy of high ideals is manifested in his life by his perseverance, integrity, belief in God, and a powerful intellect. His family and friends will miss him dearly.
