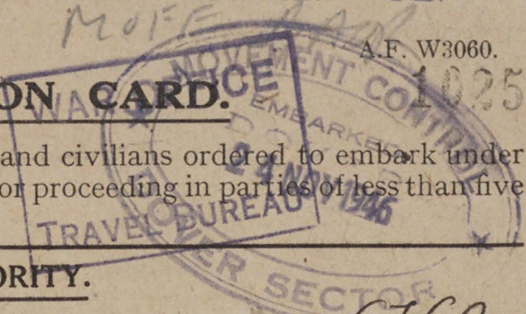

## INSTRUCTIONS.

1. Two copies of this card must accompany the individual to the port. One copy will be handed to E.S.O. on arrival at port of embarkation; the other will be handed to O.C. Troops on board for transmission to the E.S.O. at port of disembarkation. If, on a short sea voyage, no O.C. Troops has been appointed, the bearer will be responsible for handing card direct to E.S.O. on disembarkation.
2. E.S.O. at port of embarkation will be responsible for compiling, from the cards handed in, a nominal roll in triplicate on A.F. W/5169 in respect of each vessel. The A.F. W/5169 forwarded to the War Office (with others relating to the same vessel) will be supported by these cards.
3. The A.F.W/5169 forwarded to the War Office (with others relating to the same vessel) from port of disembarkation will be supported by the cards handed in to E.S.O. on arrival overseas.
4. The relevant portions of A.F.'s. W/5169 rendered to War Office under paragraphs 2 and 3 above will be filled in as appropriate and the forms signed by E.S.O.'s.
