THE MAUD GORDON HOLMES ARBORETUM sponsored by the Eighth District, Federated Garden Clubs of New York State, Inc., was established on the campus of State University College at Buffalo on the thirty-first day of October, nineteen hundred and sixty-two. On that date, Dr. Paul G.
