THE MAUD GORDON HOLMES ARBORETUM sponsored by the Eighth District, Federated Garden Clubs of New York State, Inc., was established on the campus of State University College at Buffalo on the thirty-first day of October, nineteen hundred and sixty-two. Bulger, President of the College, ceremonially accepted a Scotch Elm, the first planting of an enduring project, envisioned to provide in its maturity a treasure of natural beauty and resource for botanical studies.
