

Minutes of meeting of Holy Name Society  
held at St. John's Church, New Haven, Conn.  
on January 22, 1938.

The meeting was opened with the singing of a hymn.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

The financial report was presented.

The new officers were elected.

A motion was made by Mr. [unclear] to have a collection taken for the relief of the victims of the flood in Mississippi.

The meeting adjourned.

December 30, 1937.

The regular monthly meeting of the Holy Name Ushers was held December 30 of 1937. Minutes were read, approved and dues and fines were collected.

Having no old business to discuss John Rachwal our former president handed the gavel to our new president Joseph Oblanski and new business was started.

A motion was made by Anthony Glimezko and seconded by Stanley Klan that it will be compulsory for all ushers to pay their dues and fines; To attend. It was voted upon and passed.

All usher meetings will be held Sunday afternoons and during the summer they will be held during the week days.

If an usher misses three consecutive meetings on masses he will automatically be dropped from the usher

roster. Unless he has to work or do something important he is to notify the captain and the captain will arrange to put someone in his place.

A constitution is to be made out for the ushers division of the Holy Name Society before the next meeting. It will be made with the help of the president, Stanley Moniuszko and Secretary Leon Nyla.

The possession of the trousers will remain the property of the Holy Name Society Ushers until the usher has used them for the period of one year and not until then will they become the personal property of the ushers.

Edward Mady and Kenny Kopolski were elected auditors of the ushers for the year of 1938. It will be their duty to inspect the books four times a year or at any other time they think it necessary.

The annual usher dance is to be held  
Sunday January 30.

Vincent Stansawski was elected chairman  
of the dance and Leon Hyla as co-chairman.  
All ushers, without exception are to help in  
the affair.

It was decided to present Frank  
Pawlak our former captain with a gold  
pin for his exceptional work as captain  
for the year of 1937.

An usher rehearsal was set for  
January 9<sup>th</sup> after 12:00 O'clock Mass.


