## About Us

In the fall of 2001, a group of local individuals were called upon to take part in a "just a few meetings" to begin to address the issue of domestic violence in the LGBT WNY community. The effort was initiated by Haven House in the recognition that adequate services for victims of LGBT domestic violence have been relatively non-existent in our community. Those *few meetings* have since grown into a community-wide effort to stop domestic violence in the LGBT community. Since then a core group of dedicated volunteers has met monthly with a focus on increasing public awareness and the development of services. This has been a committed, get-things-done, fun group that has managed to accomplish quite a bit in a short amount of time. This has included the creation of:

- A **Safe Home** to provide emergency shelter for LGBT victims and their children
- **Palm Cards** highlighting facts and information about LGBT domestic violence
- **Brochures** which provide extensive information about how to identify domestic violence and how to get help
- **Kick-off concert** event as part of the YWCA's *Week Without Violence* and national *Domestic Violence Awareness Month*

- Advocacy and support for Haven House's initiative to develop LGBT Safe Homes
- Public awareness of the issues surrounding LGBT domestic violence and the need for services
- Development of services for victims of LGBT domestic violence
- Fostering collaboration at all levels of service provision
