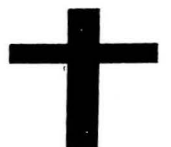

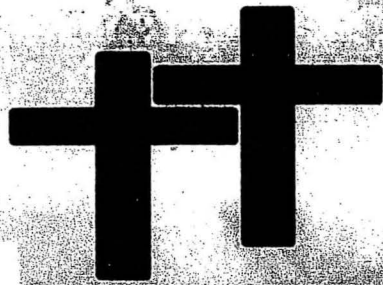

Thank you for your prayers, along with the help and many kindnesses you have provided us. You have meant so much to us in our hour of distress. May God shower his blessings upon you, too!



CHURCH COVENANT
