## **Program Notes**

#### Carry The Light Down

The brain child of Seattle composer David Maddux, who has composed and arranged music in a variety of applications for over three decades, *Carry the Light Down* is likely an unfamiliar song to most of you, but one you will leave tonight tapping your feet to and humming for days to come. In the spirit of our Holiday message, Merry & Bright, *Carry the Light Down* reminds all of us to keep the joy and glee of this magical season burning bright within.

#### White Christmas

Certainly one of the two best-known songs (with God Bless America) by Irving Berlin, this Holiday standard was written in 1940, but hit the spotlight when Bing Crosby sang it in the 1942 movie, "Holiday Inn". Bing's 1942 recording with John Scott Trotter's orchestra and the Ken Darby Singers became the greatest hit of its time. Tonight, we sing it for you with the hope that all of your days be **Merry and Bright**!

#### The Christmas Waltz

*The Christmas Waltz* is a Christmas song written by Sammy Cahn and Jule Styne for Frank Sinatra, who recorded it in 1954 as a B-side to a new recording of *White Christmas.* This is the first Christmas Waltz to be written and is referenced in the line, "and this song of mine, in three quarter time." The lyrics are full of sentimental Christmas memories and will make you want to grab a loved one and waltz.

#### Ma'oz Tzur

*Ma'oz Tzur* (Rock of Ages) is a Jewish poem, written in Hebrew, and sung on Hanukkah, after the festival of lights. Thought to be written sometime in the late 13th century, Ma'oz Tzur has come to be known as the Hanukkah melody. Set to music by the typically tongue-in-cheek Eric Lane Barnes, this version of Ma'oz Tzur is beautifully bright and full of energy.

#### Ave Maria

Tomas Luis de Victoria was the most famous composer in 16th-century Spain. He devoted his life and career exclusively to the genre of sacred music of the late Renaissance, and is the most highly regarded and accomplished composer of the Counter-Reformation. His composition of Ave Maria or the 'Angelic Salutation' as it is also called is based upon two passages in Luke the greeting by the Angel Gabriel (Luke 1: 28) and Elizabeth's acclamation (Luke 1: 42). It's use as a prayer dates back to the eleventh century.

Sung by a small group of our Buffalo Gay Men's Chorus, this beautiful piece of music will surely inspire you, as it has inspired thousands of others over the last 450 years.

#### Silver Bells

Written by Jay Livingston and Ray Evans, Silver Bells was written in 1950 for the Paramount picture "The Lemon-Drop Kid", featuring the legendary Bob Hope. Livingston and Evans were challenged to write a Christmas song for the film, but were reluctant to write a Christmas song, citing that it was near impossible to write a hit Christmas song. Originally they wrote a song called Tinkle Bell, about the Santa Clauses and the Salvation Army workers who stand on New York City street corners tinkling their bells. Realizing what most Americans would think of an alternative meaning to the word "tinkle", they put aside Tinkle Bell and started to write a new song, using the music and melody of Tinkle Bell, and changing the word "tinkle" to "silver".

#### Nella Fantasia

Nella Fantasia, (In My Fantasy) was originally an instrumental written by composer Ennio Morricone for the 1986 film, "The Mission". Words were added by Italian song writer, Chiara Ferraù for the 1998 Sarah Brightman Album, Eden. The song has been covered by many artists, including the all male group Il Divo, in 2004. Nella Fantasia is a beautiful song, where we are reminded to never stop dreaming, and to always see our world as one that is bright, friendly, full of peace and honesty.

#### Betelehemu

The story of *Betelehemu's* creation is almost as uplifting as the song itself. The late Babatunde Olatunji, a renowned Nigerian drummer, educator, social activist, and recording artist, was awarded the prestigious Rotary International Scholarship, and relocated to the United States for an education in music at the age of 23. Once in Atlanta, Georgia, Olatunji collaborated with his college's GLEE Club Director Dr. Wendell P. Whalum to create this motivational piece of religious praise.


#### Drunken Sailor on Christmas Morning

#### Santa Baby

Originally recorded by Eartha Kitt in 1953, *Santa Baby* is a "tongue in cheek" look at a Christmas list from a woman to Santa Claus, hoping for extravagant gifts like a sable, a yacht or decorations from Tiffany's. As we sing our rendition of Santa Baby, it is perhaps even more "tongue in cheek" as we sing the song from a male perspective with all of the same requests for Santa Claus. The song has been covered by many artists including Madonna, as well as a slight re-telling from Michael Buble called *Santa Buddy*.

#### Do You Hear What I Hear

Written by Noel Regney and Gloria Shayne in 1962, *Do You Hear What I Hear* is another song made popular by recording dynamo, Bing Crosby in 1963. Written as a plea for peace during the Cuban Missile Crisis, *Do You Hear What I Hear* is a song with deep emotional complexity, with one beautifully clear message of peace, acceptance, and love.

#### Silent Night

180 years ago the carol *Stille Nacht! Heilige Nacht* was heard for the first time in a village church in Oberndorf, Austria. The congregation at that Midnight Mass in St. Nicholas Church listened as the voices of the assistant pastor, Fr. Joseph Mohr, and the choir director, Franz Xavier Gruber, rang through the church to the accompaniment of Fr. Mohr's guitar. On each of the six verses, the choir repeated the last two lines in four-part harmony. Now translated into hundreds of languages, *Silent Night* is sung by millions the world over every December. Its powerful message of heavenly peace has crossed borders and language barriers, conquering the hearts of people everywhere.

#### Heavy Christmas

*Heavy Christmas* is a clever arrangement by David Maddux, offering new Christmas lyrics to famous classical themes, featuring works by Wagner, Verdi, Bizet and Tchaikovsky among others. We look forward to your reaction to Verdi's *The Anvil Chorus* - now a holiday carol to delight.



## About the Accompanist




Jonathan Rizzo has been performing as a pianist, keyboardist, and percussionist in the WNY area for the past decade. Originally studying percussion and euphonium as a music education major at SUNY Fredonia, he began to take seriously the idea of performing as a pianist after studying there with international award-winning pianist Sean Duggan After graduating Fredonia with a Bachelor's Degree in

Music Education, Mr. Rizzo began studying classically with pianist Steven Bianchi and then with Dr. Emily Boyce at Buffalo State College. While at Buffalo State, he won the school's concerto competition, performing the first movement of Mozart's Piano Concerto No.20 in D Minor with the Buffalo State Philharmonia.

Mr. Rizzo holds the position of "Music Accompanist" at St. James UCC in Hamburg, performing services on both piano and organ.

As a member of the band Blueshift, Mr. Rizzo has performed at many venues both in Western New York and beyond, playing such events as Warped Tour in Cincinnati and The Niagara Falls Arts Festival, and has opened for such internationally-known acts as Tony Levin's Stickmen and Green Jelly. Locally, Blueshift frequently performs at venues such as The Tralf and Mister Goodbar.





## The Buffalo Gay Men's Chorus

At end of 1999, the vision for a Gay Men's Chorus in Buffalo was conceived. Guided by Roger Parris, a vigorous group of men explored this concept thoroughly. With the support and success of the Rochester Gay Men's Chorus behind them, these men decided that it was time for Buffalo to join the growing list of LGBT choruses all over the world.

After 15 months of intense work, a Steering Committee had written bylaws, filed papers of incorporation, raised seed money, written a mission statement and elected officers. After a thorough search, Barbara Wagner was asked to be the Founding Artistic Director and would join the ranks of only two female conductors of Gay Men's Choruses. Wagner, in turn, requested that Debi Overton-Niles be invited to serve as the Founding Accompanist.

The first auditions were held in May 2001, and rehearsals were to begin on September 11, 2001, a day of infamy in our nation. The men and Wagner held hands that first rehearsal and sang- "from you I receive, to you I give, together we share and from this we live." We also learned "How Can I Keep From Singing" and began forging the bonds that still hold us together today. "How Can I Keep From Singing" became our theme song and was the very first music our first audience heard as the Buffalo Gay Men's Chorus processed down the aisles of the Unitarian Universalist Church of Buffalo.

Our February 2002 inaugural concert, "Music From the Heart", set the tone for our future. The energy that surrounded the BGMC that night validated the reality of our beloved chorus, and the bonds we formed continue to remain strong. The audience that first night was huge- the church was filled, chairs lined the aisles and sadly, people had to be turned away at the door. Our audiences continue to be large and diverse, and we now sing three performances in each concert series.

We have been the gracious recipients of many awards, including three awards from Artvoice's "Best in Buffalo" found us elected as "Best Chorus" and the prestigious Buffalo and Erie County Arts Council Award for exceptional contributions to the arts and cultural community in Western New York. The BGMC has also been a recipient of community service awards from AIDS Community Services, and has been recognized by the Empire State Pride Agenda in 2005 with the ESPA Award for Community Service for the excellence of their music and their dedication to the community. We have also had the tremendous honor of performing with the Buffalo Philharmonic Orchestra twice, once in 2004 and again in 2006 under the direction of Joann Faletta. We have also performed on the Ars Nova "Viva Vivaldi" series, by the request of Marylouise Nanna.


