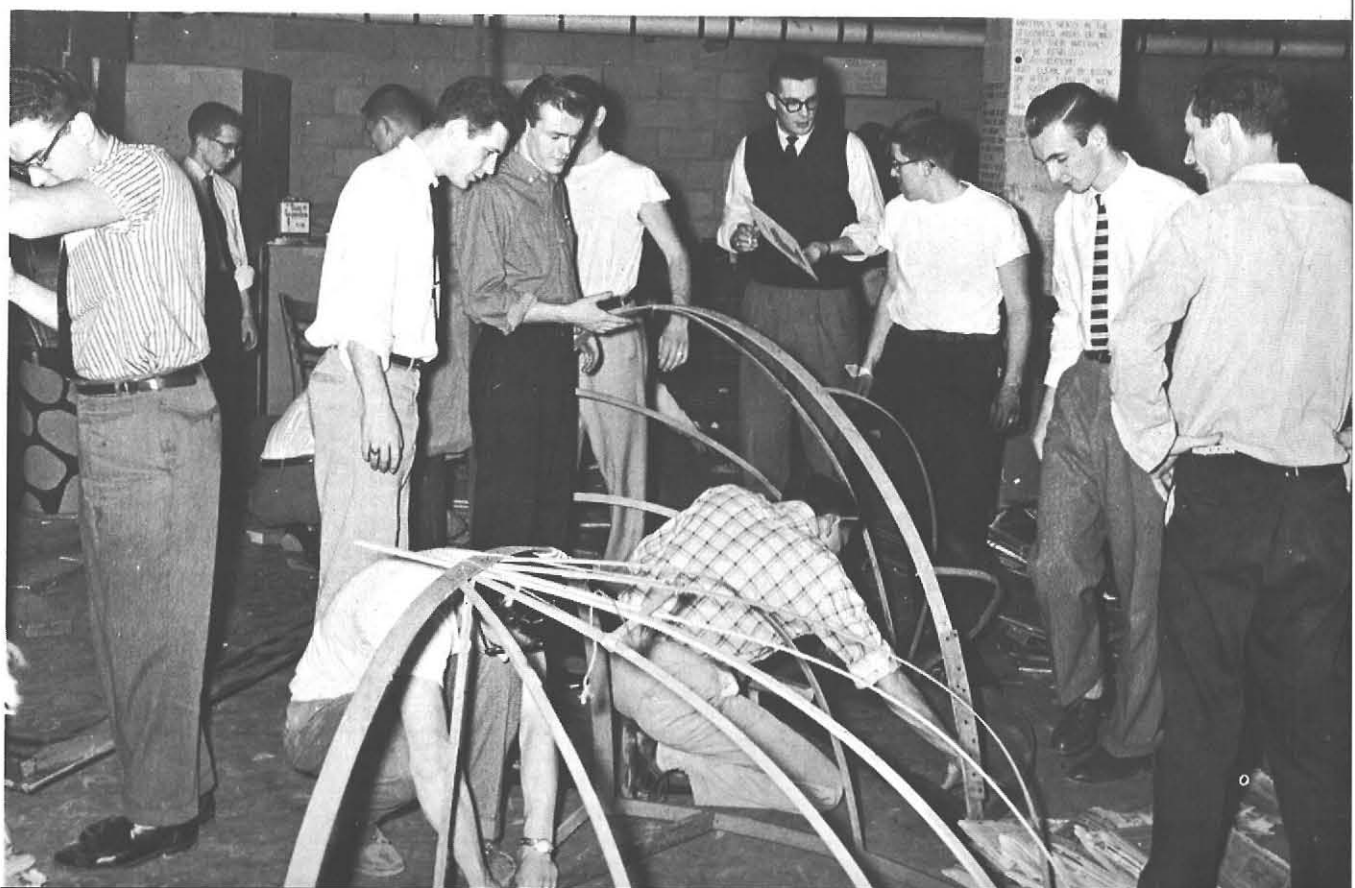


Well known in almost every organization, and leaders in many, the men in blue lead an active campus life.
