History #I & II Ysher Boards ^{4/23/50}

 first celebrated anniversary of our two
 Ysher Boards. I have enjoyed many of
 the benefits of the Ysher services I
 have not only received but also
 to me as that which is a privilege
 relating the history of the Ysher
 Boards of this Church. It is always
 to our advantage to know the
 history of ourselves, associates, and
 our accomplishments so I am going
 to take you through a process of
 retrospection. The very first Ysher
 Board of the Friendship Baptist Ch. was
 organized in ^{the Spring of 1924} 1924 during the Pastorate
 of its organizer Rev. F. B. Robinson, when
 the Church was located at 448 Clinton
 St. Corner of Pratt. Mr. M. L. Evans who
 is now a loyal member at Belgium Baptist
