Dr. Donald Swartz, former Vice-President for Academic Affairs filled the role of interim President.





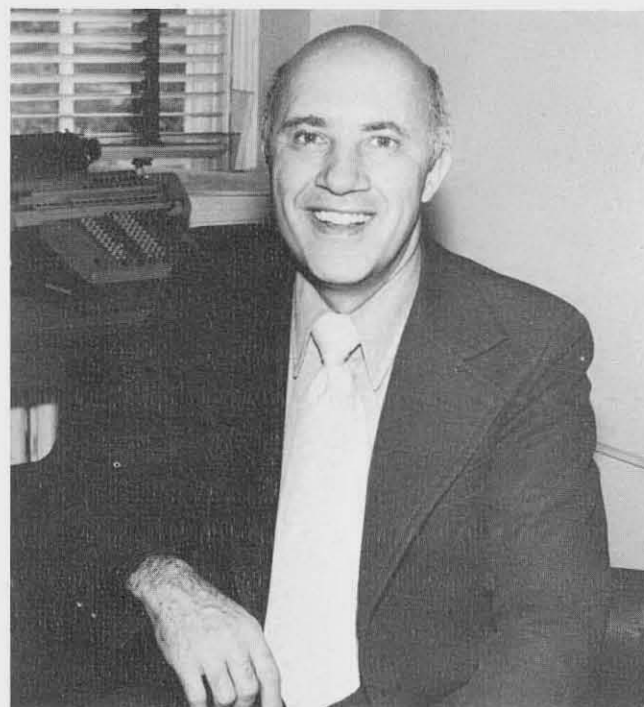

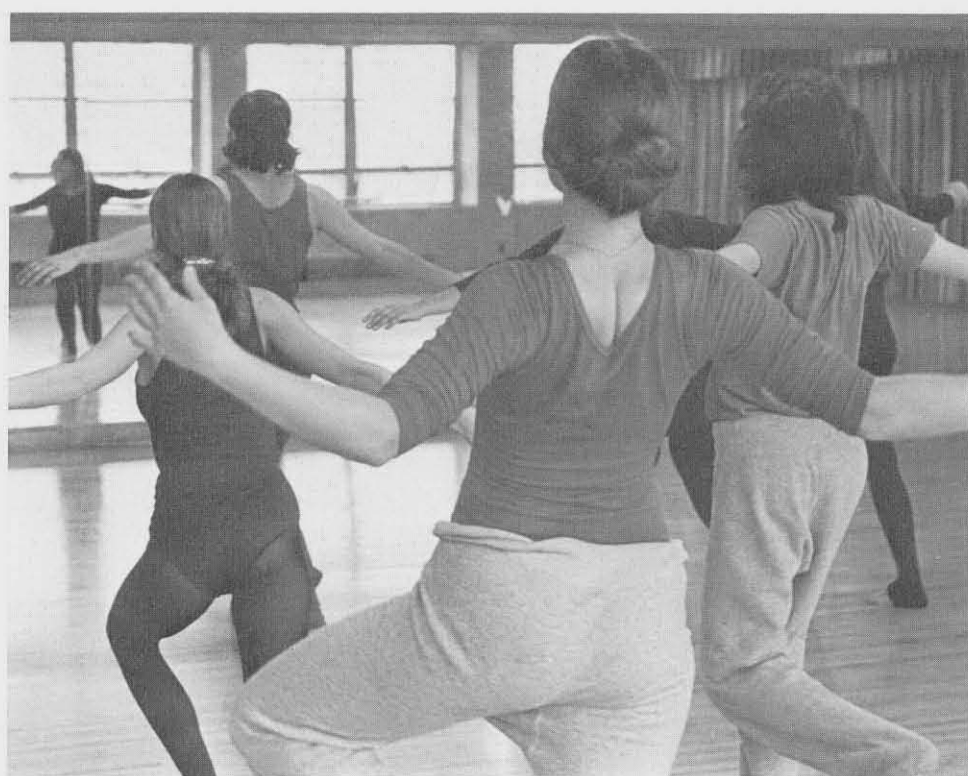


DANCING AT STATE

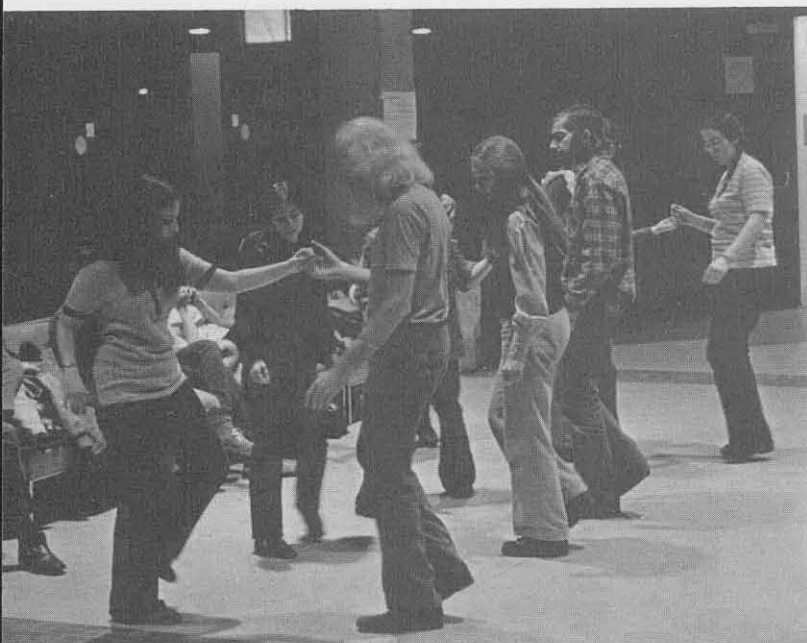


For involved and enthusiastic dancers, it is an art utilized to convey various conceptual ideologies through gestures and body movements; it is their way of communicating.

A concert of music, yes!; but more than that, a concert of stories. Stories filled with dancing and mime that made a modern electronic production come alive.

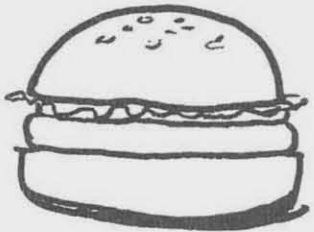
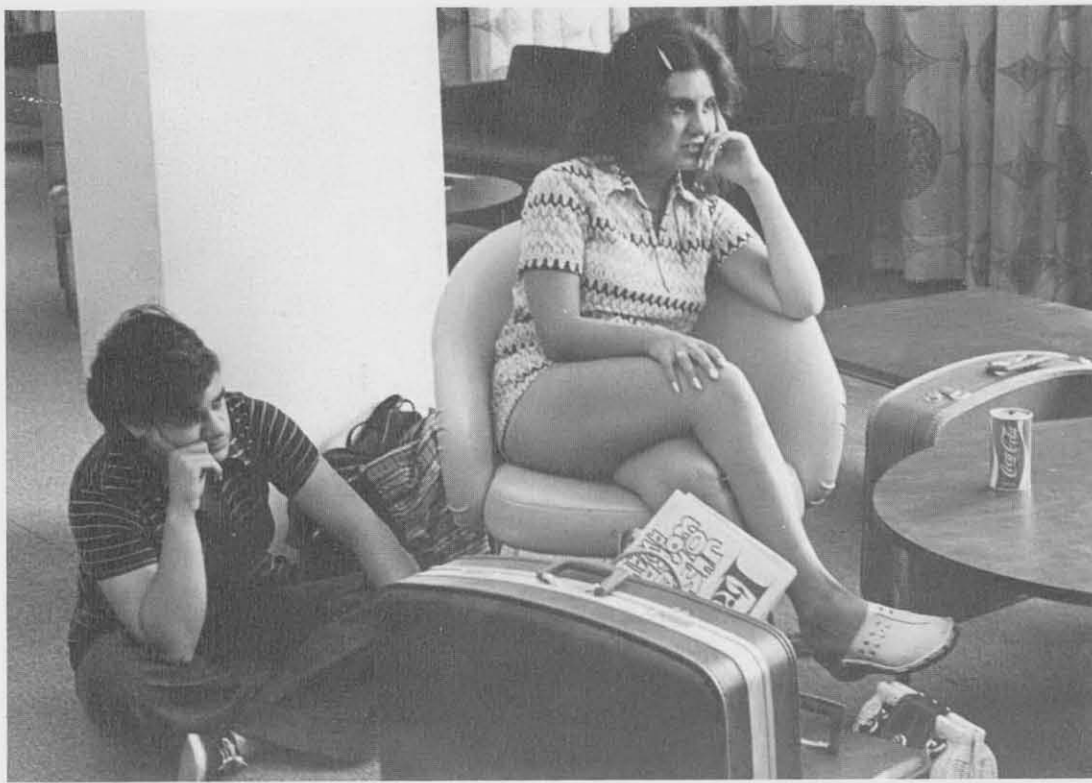

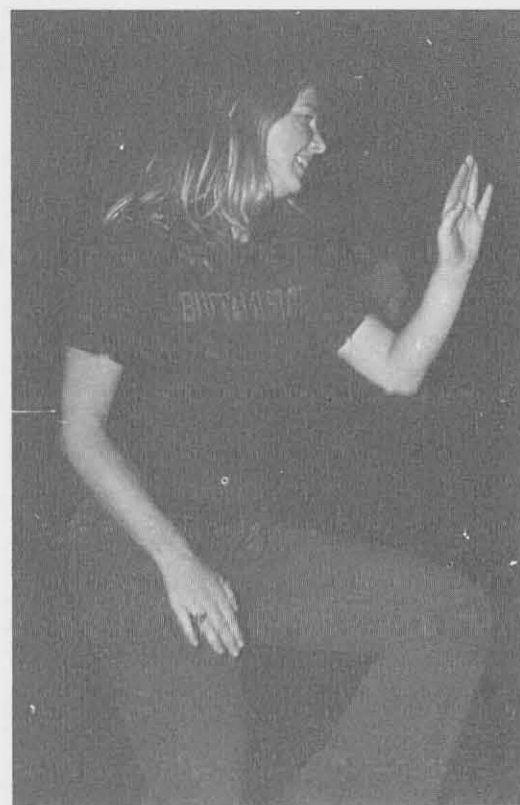
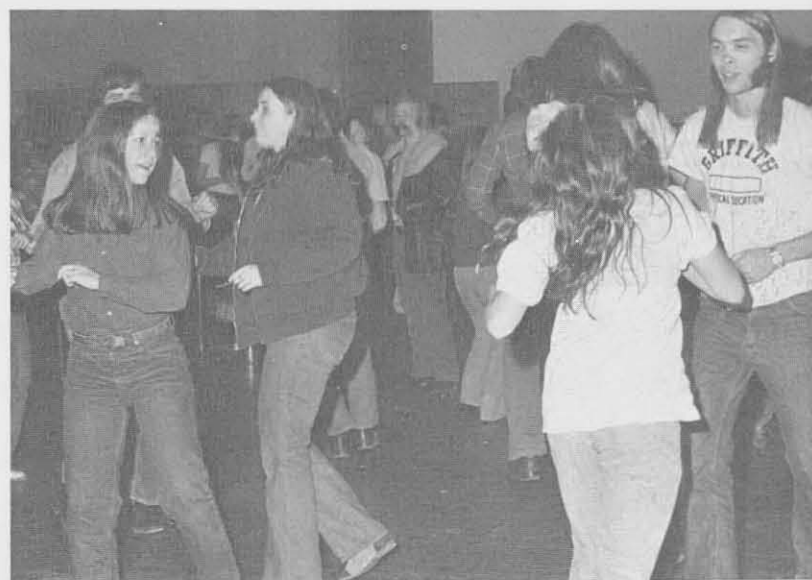






A number of events both musical and other types were slated November 2-4, 1973 for the Buffalo State Homecoming Weekend sponsored by Student Union Board.

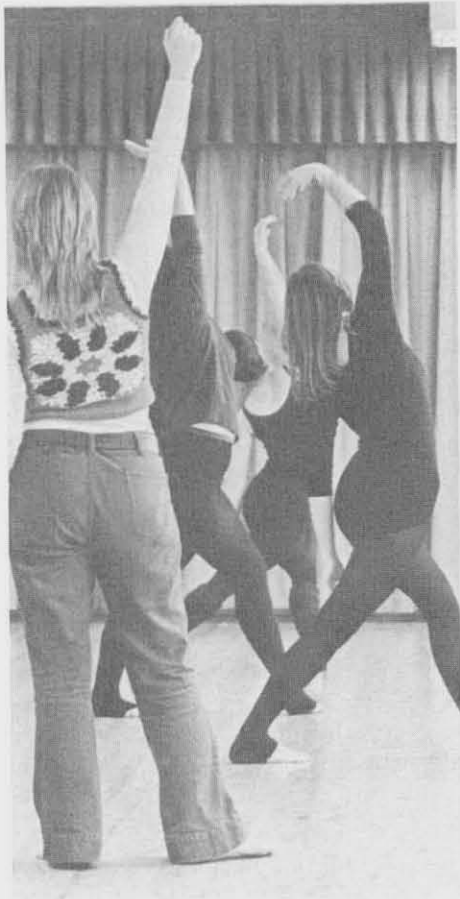




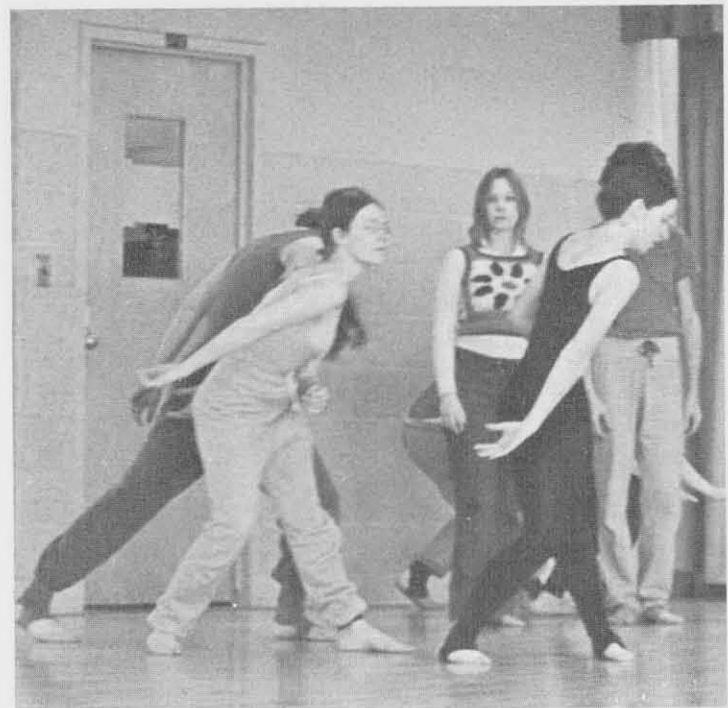
FLEA MARKET
