Student Senate



The United Students' Government seeks to represent and advocate the needs and interests of all undergraduate students attending the State University College at Binghamton. USG sponsors educational, social and recreational activities funded by approximately \$500,000 collected annually from mandatory student activity fees. The United Students' Government attempts to encourage the active involvement of students in all aspects of campus life.

Judicial Council

The A.A.M.D.'s (American Association of Misfits and Deviates) latest definition of Judicial Council is:

Judicial Council refers to those elected students with nonexistent general intellectual functioning which originates in the undergraduate period and is associated with impairment in rational behavior.


Commuter Council
