In order to show you where her heart is I want to publish part of her letter she sent to our chairperson Ann Hill.)

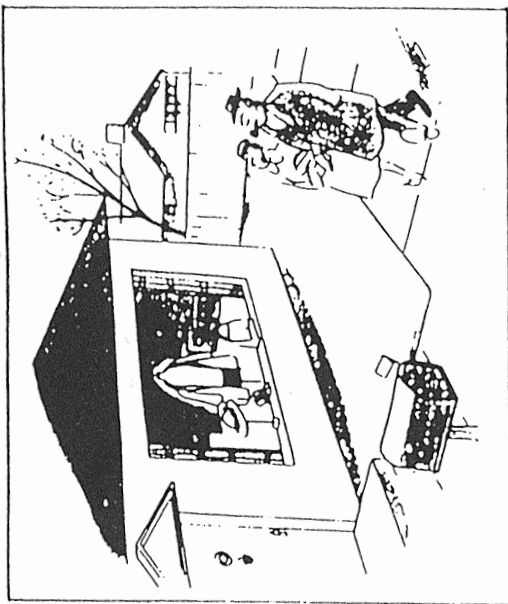

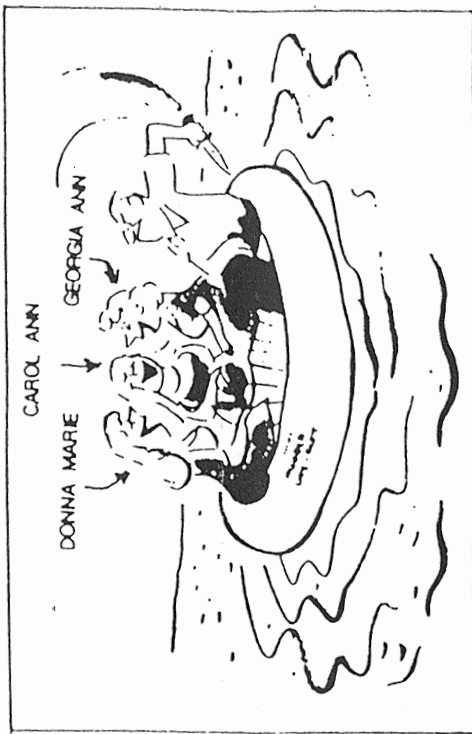

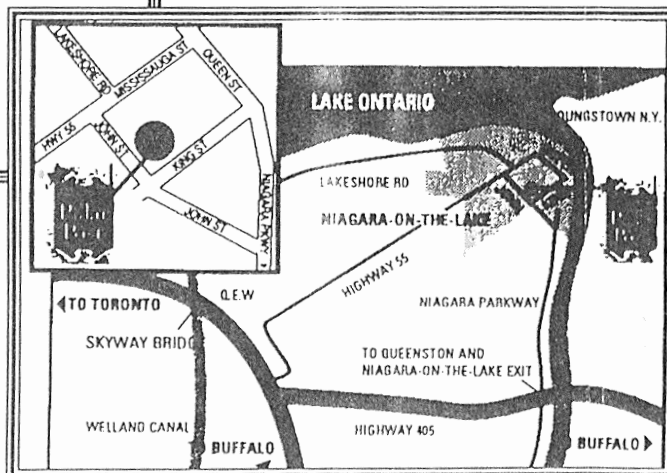
