
THANK YOU, MADAM PRESIDENT. I AM PLEASED TO REPORT THE 1989 ELECTION RESULTS. I WILL READ THE ACCOMPANYING CERTIFICATION LETTER FROM THE AUDITING FIRM OF COOPERS AND LYBRAND TO MARTHA L. ORR, EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR.

DEAR MS. ORR:

WE CONFIRM THAT THE RESULTS OF THE 1989 ELECTIONS WERE DETERMINED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROCEDURES ENUMERATED BELOW. THE ATTACHED SCHEDULES ARE INCLUDED IN OUR ELECTION REPORT TO YOU. THE PROCEDURES EMPLOYED BY US ARE MODELED AFTER THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE PUBLIC ELECTION LAW. OUR PROCEDURES ARE AS FOLLOWS:

- A DOUBLE ENVELOPE BALLOT WAS RECEIVED AT A POST OFFICE 1. THE DOUBLE ENVELOPE BALLOT SYSTEM ENSURED SECRECY.
- 2. UPON RECEIPT OF THE BALLOTS, COOPERS AND LYBRAND MATCHED THE INFORMATION ON THE BALLOT IDENTIFICATION CARD TO THE MEMBER LIST PROVIDED BY THE NEW YORK STATE NURSES ASSOCIATION. AFTER VERIFYING THE VALIDITY OF THE VOTER'S MEMBERSHIP, COOPERS AND LYBRAND OPENED THE INNER ENVELOPE AND EXAMINED THE BALLOTS FOR PROPER COMPLETION.






