Ora B. Page was born November 5, 1916 in Greensboro, Alabama to the late Breen and Velma Burroughs-Brown

She was baptized at Mt. Siani Baptist Church in Greensboro.

On December 15, 1934 she was united in holy matrimony to Y.C. Page, and moved from Alabama to Niagara Falls, N.Y. in 1940, and subsequently to Buffalo, N.Y. in 1959, where she united with the Pilgrim Baptist Church.
