Rockwell Hall, the original building on campus, has become the identifying symbol of the college. Recently remodeled, it now houses classrooms and rehearsal rooms for the music department, the 900 seat theater for the Performing Arts Center, and the internationally known Burchfield Art Center.

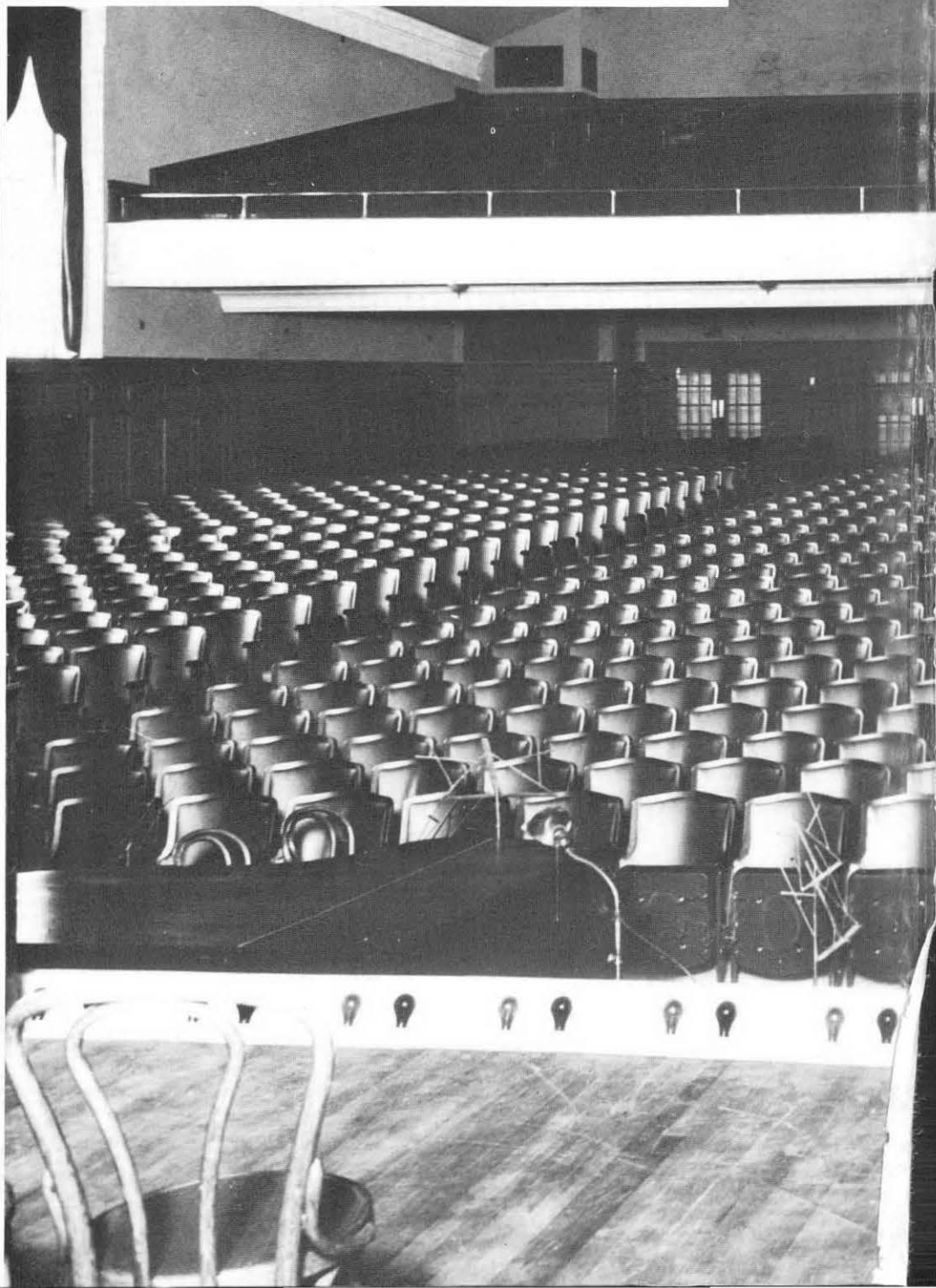
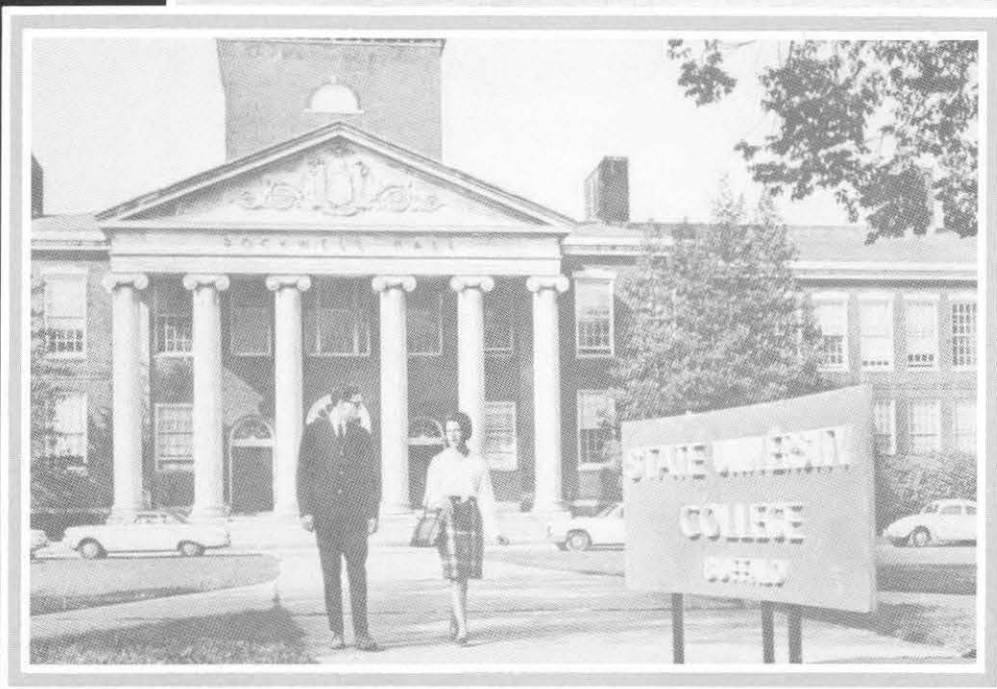

There is one place on the Buffalo State campus that reflects this book's theme like a polished crystal: Rockwell Hall. The many facets of the history and use of this building show BSC as a place where we look to the future without losing sight of our past.

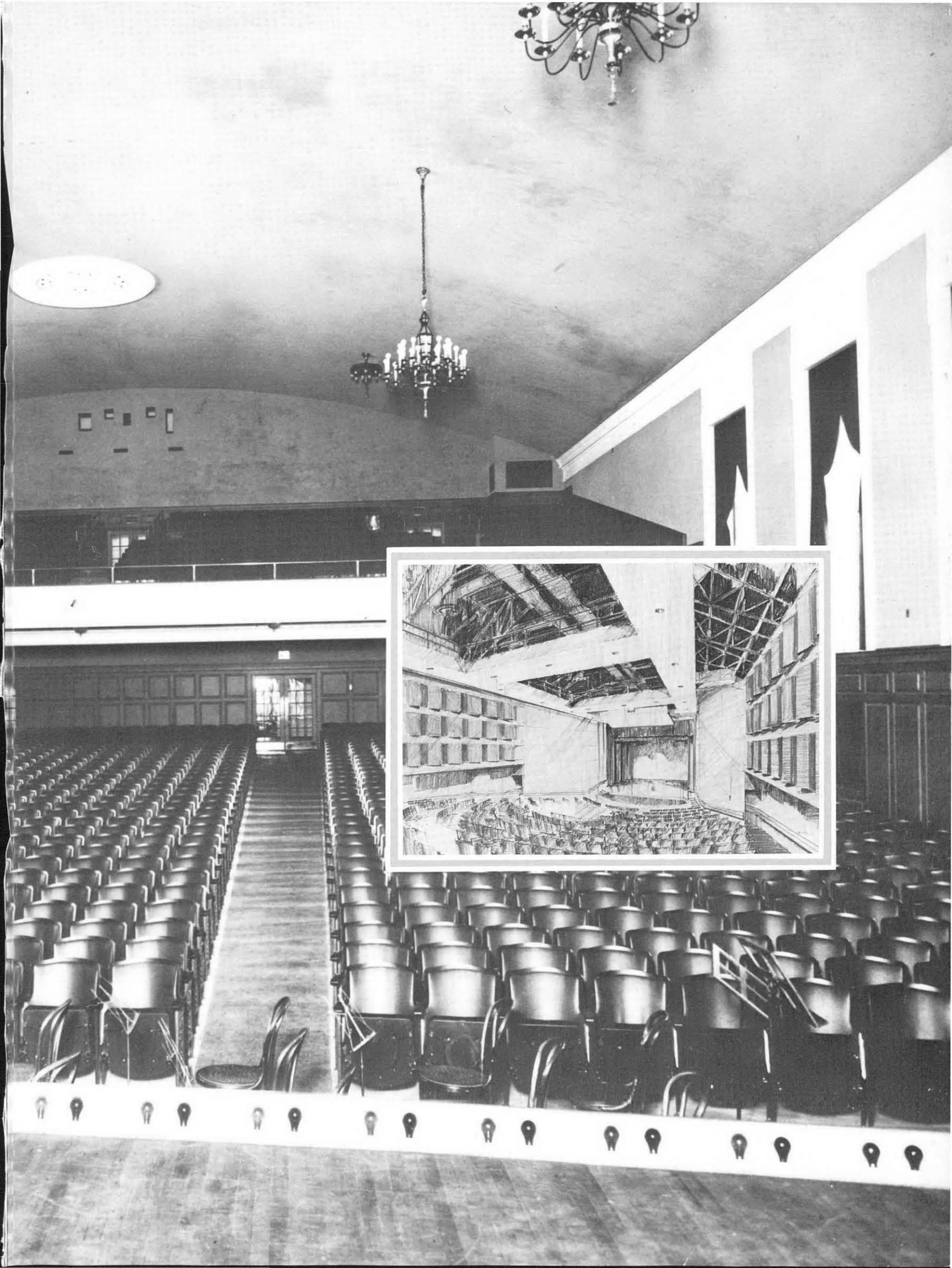
During the 1980's the building was completely renovated. Yet, while the need was there to make a facility as modern and functional as possible, the desire was there to keep as much of the original flavor of this, the original campus building.

To that end the bell tower and weather vane were restored. Windows were replaced with windows that appeared the same, but were highly energy efficient. And the old auditorium, a facility that had fallen to use as a junk store-room, was rebuilt by emptying the shell of the

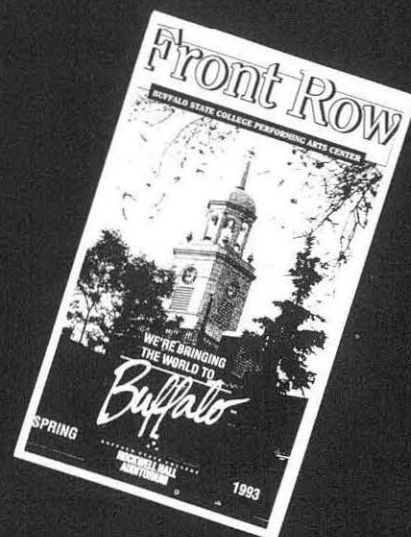
building and constructing a new theater complex inside, from scratch.

Rockwell Hall is also the site of three institutions dedicated to preserving things for the future: The Art Conservation Department, The Burchfield Art Center, and the Metcalfe Rooms.

The Art Conservation Department is one of only two places in the country where college students can come to learn the processes used to restore and preserve drawings, paintings, sculptures, and other works of art. The department's classrooms and laboratories are all contained in the north wing of Rockwell Hall.

The Burchfield Art center opened in the 1960's as a gallery and repository for the works of Charles Burchfield and other Western New York artists. Some 4000 pieces are in the collection and 1993 marked a milestone for the Center when it published a collected volume of Burchfield's journals, and sent a traveling exhibition of his work across the country in celebration of the 100th anniversary of his birth.

When the Metcalfe house, a Buffalo architectural landmark designed in 1882 by renowned architects McKim, Mead and White, was demolished in 1980, the interiors of two rooms, the library and the dining room, were moved to the first floor of Rockwell Hall. The wood paneling, fireplaces and other fixtures were carefully reconstructed, so that visitors today can see what these rooms looked like during Buffalo's heyday as a Great Lakes port.



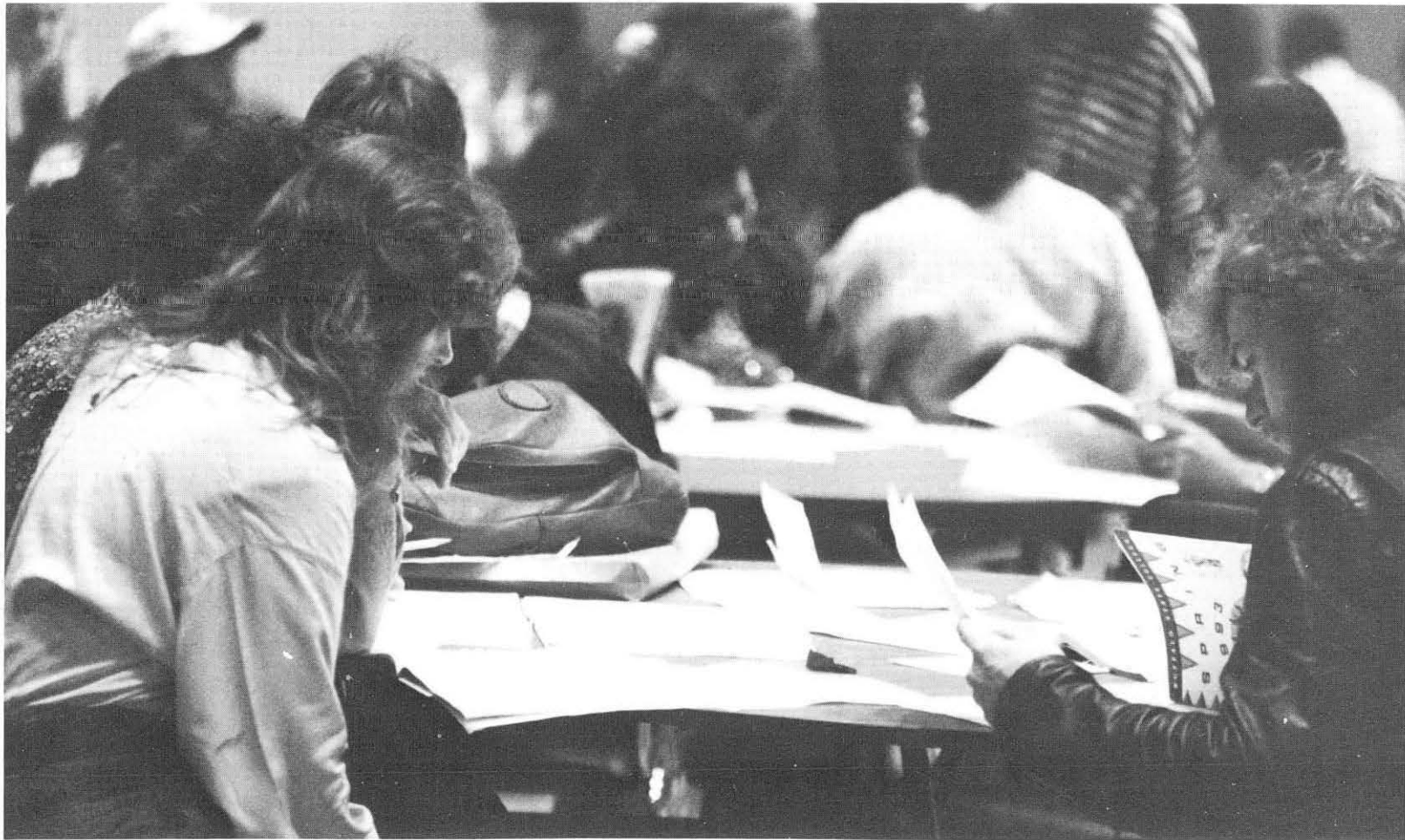


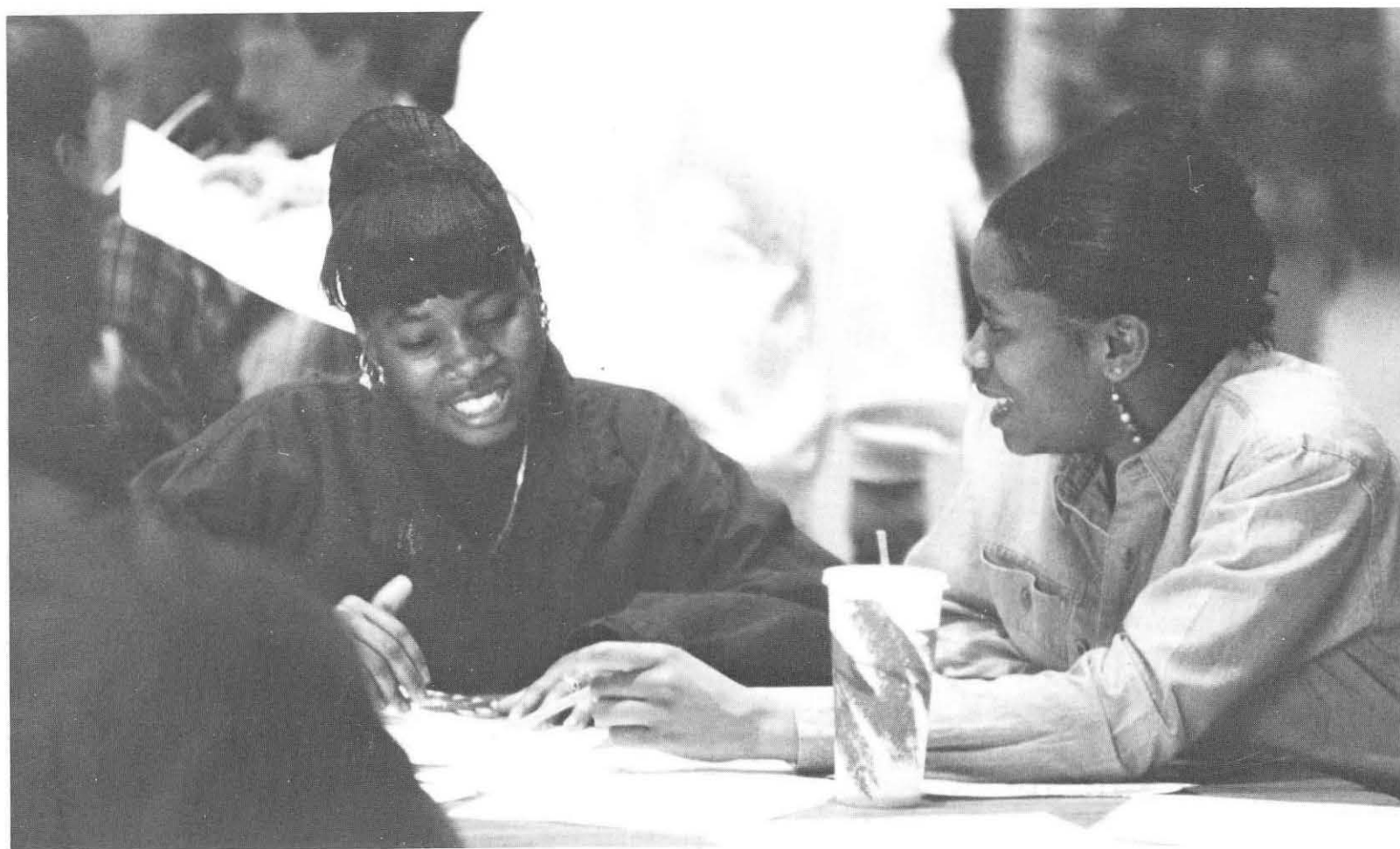


First Things First

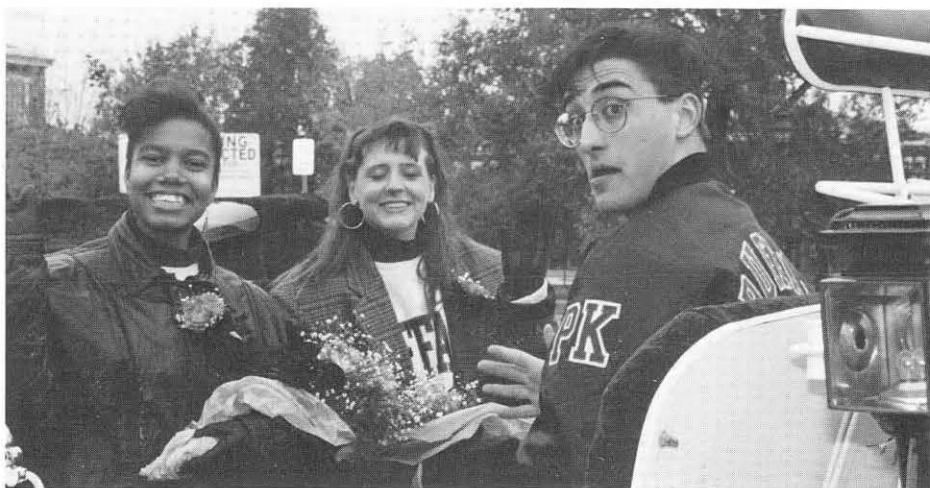




HOMECOMING 92

Remodeled Theater Arts Building Provides New Facility For Casting Hall Productions

On September 19, 1993 BSC opened the Theater Arts Building in what was once a campus gymnasium. The \$3 million renovation included construction of a TV production studio, seminar and rehearsal rooms, student and faculty offices, a design studio, a computer lab, backstage make-up and waiting areas, and the "Black Box Theater."

Casting Hall had wasted no time, staging its first production, "Brilliant Traces," in the theater that same weekend.

Various administration, faculty, alumni, and students took place in the ribbon cutting ceremony on the steps of the new facility. Among the

alumni present: Channel 7 sportscaster Brenda Brenon, Channel 4 anchor Kevin O'Connell, Channel 2 anchor Laurie Lisowski, Jody Sunshine from CBS's "60 Minutes," and state assemblyman Sam Hoyt.

BURCHFIELD ART CENTER

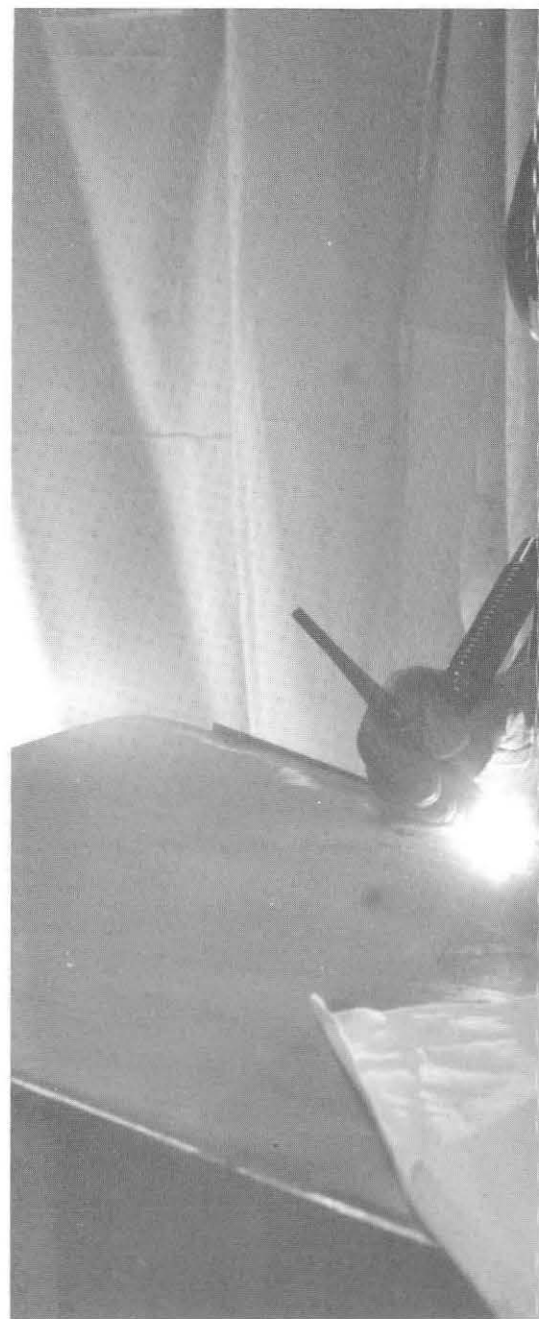
Located on the third floor of Rockwell Hall, the Burchfield Art Center is the Museum for Western New York arts. It is dedicated to acclaimed American watercolorist Charles E. Burchfield (1893-1967), a friend and consulting artist to BSC. The Center holds the world's largest public Burchfield collection (approximately 500 works), as well as works by other artists who have lived or practiced in Western New York State.

The Center offers unique opportunities for Buffalo State College students to gain experience in the arts. Students from a variety of majors, including fine arts, design, journalism, and business, become involved each year as volunteers and interns.

In 1993, the Center presented its fourth annual competition for a Buffalo State student to plan and create a site-specific installation for its Central Gallery. This year's winner was Michael D. Dominick, a 1993 recipient of a Bachelor of Fine Arts degree in Sculpture. His installation "Unknown Boundaries" contrasted cotton fabric with large geometric sheet metal structures designed for the wall and alcoves of the Gallery. The exhibition was made possible through a grant from the Faculty Student Association of Buffalo State College. Additional assistance was provided to the artist by Hebeler Welding Inc., A. & J. Distributors Inc., Buffalo Sheet Metal, and Basil Division of AMSCO Inc.

Wilderness Adventures Club Spends Spring Break Nature Hiking

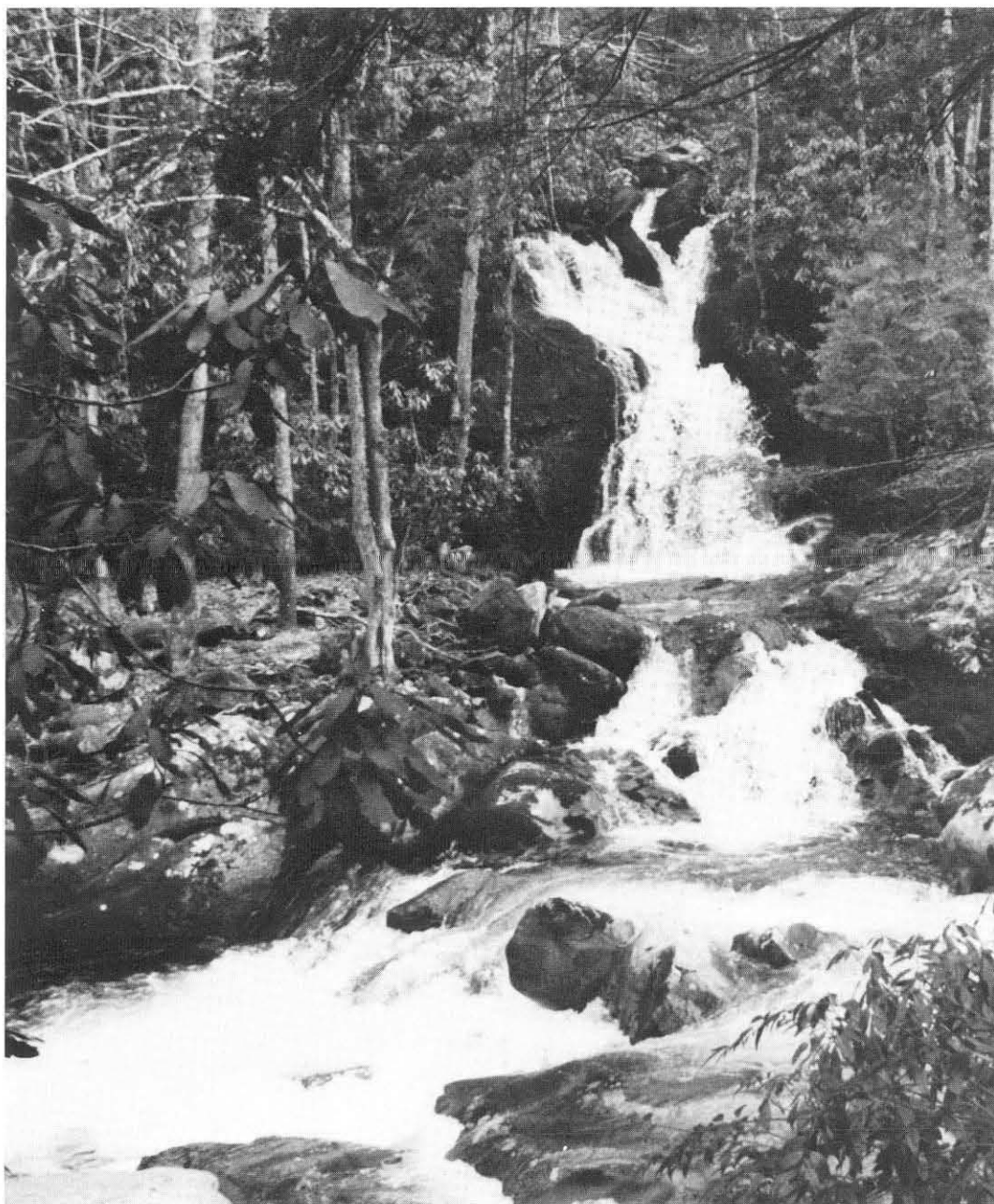
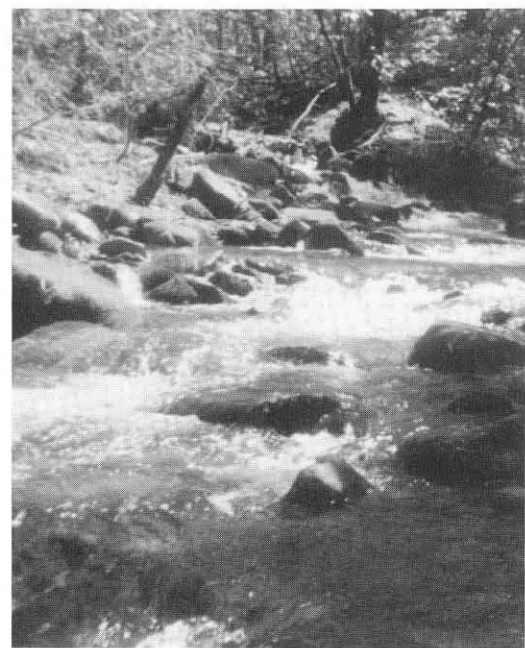
GREAT SMOKEY MOUNTAINS BACKPACK EXCURSION

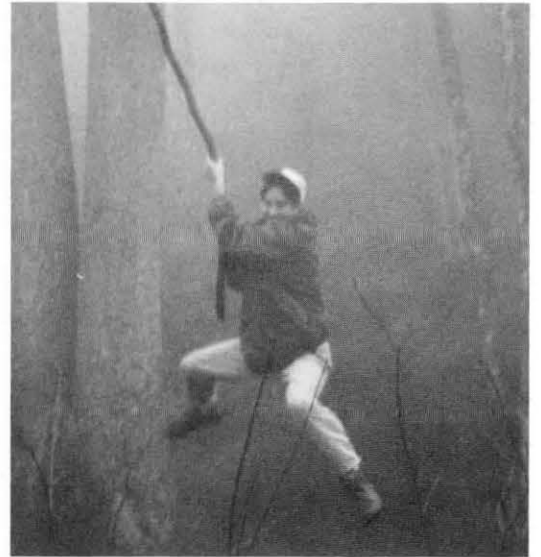
The rushing streams provided all of the fresh water needed by the hikers.

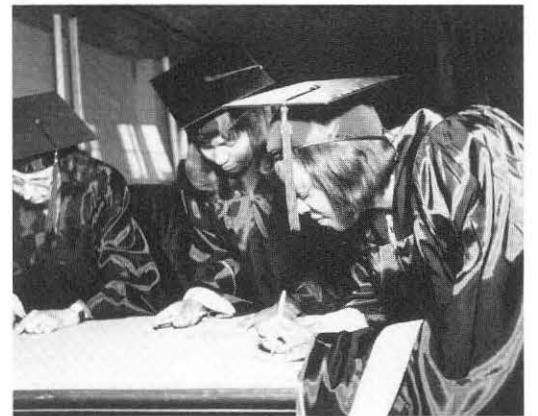


The 121st Commencement Ceremonies

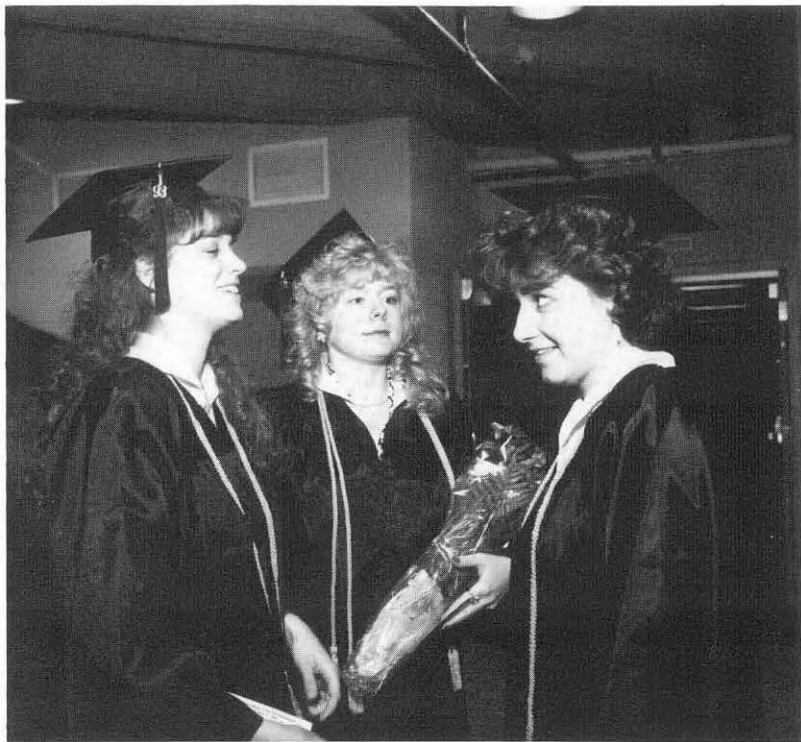
On May 21, 1993 the Buff State campus was filled with hundreds of happy, smiling people.

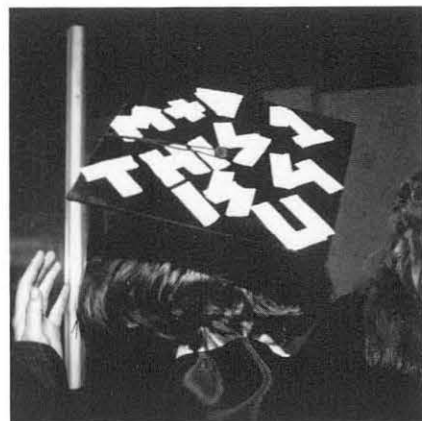

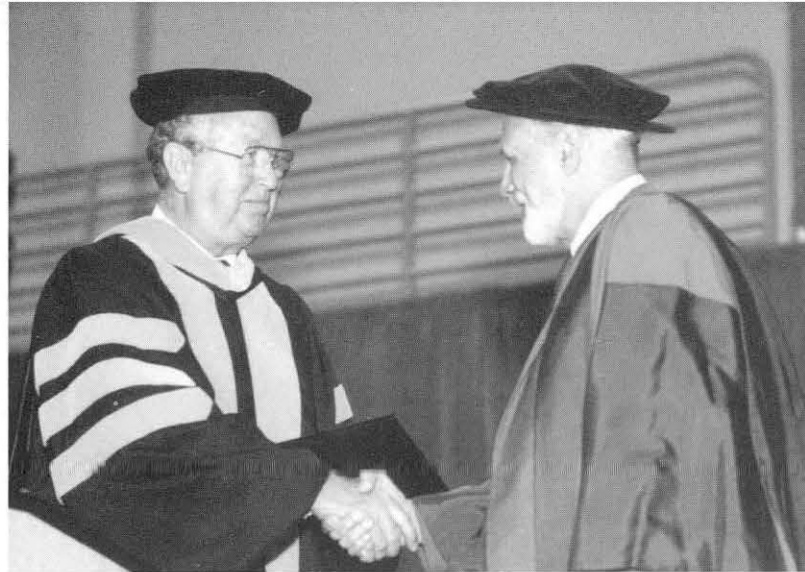
The Ceremonies

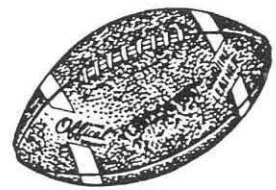
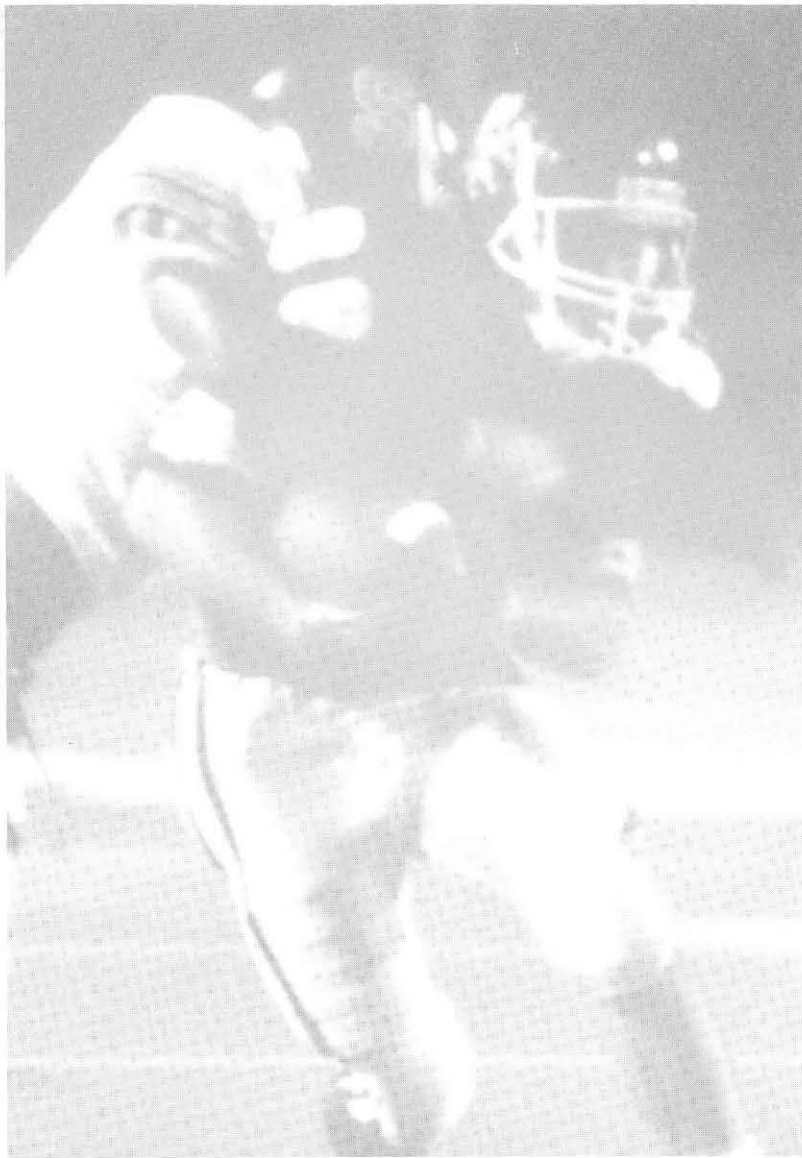
Fall FOOTBALL

The football team lived up to the highest preseason expectations it ever had. Behind the most prolific passer in school history, Jim Weigel, the Bengals

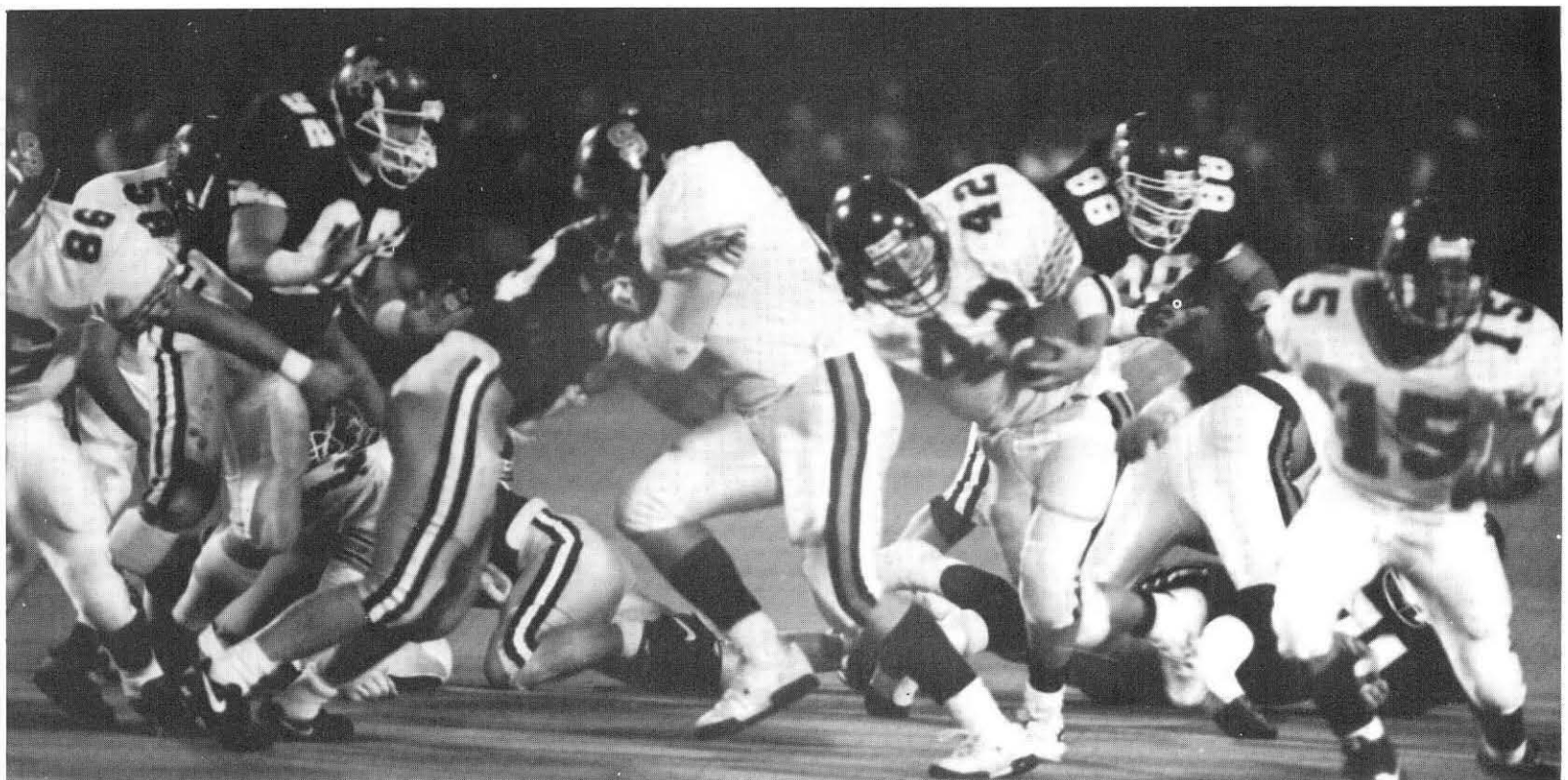

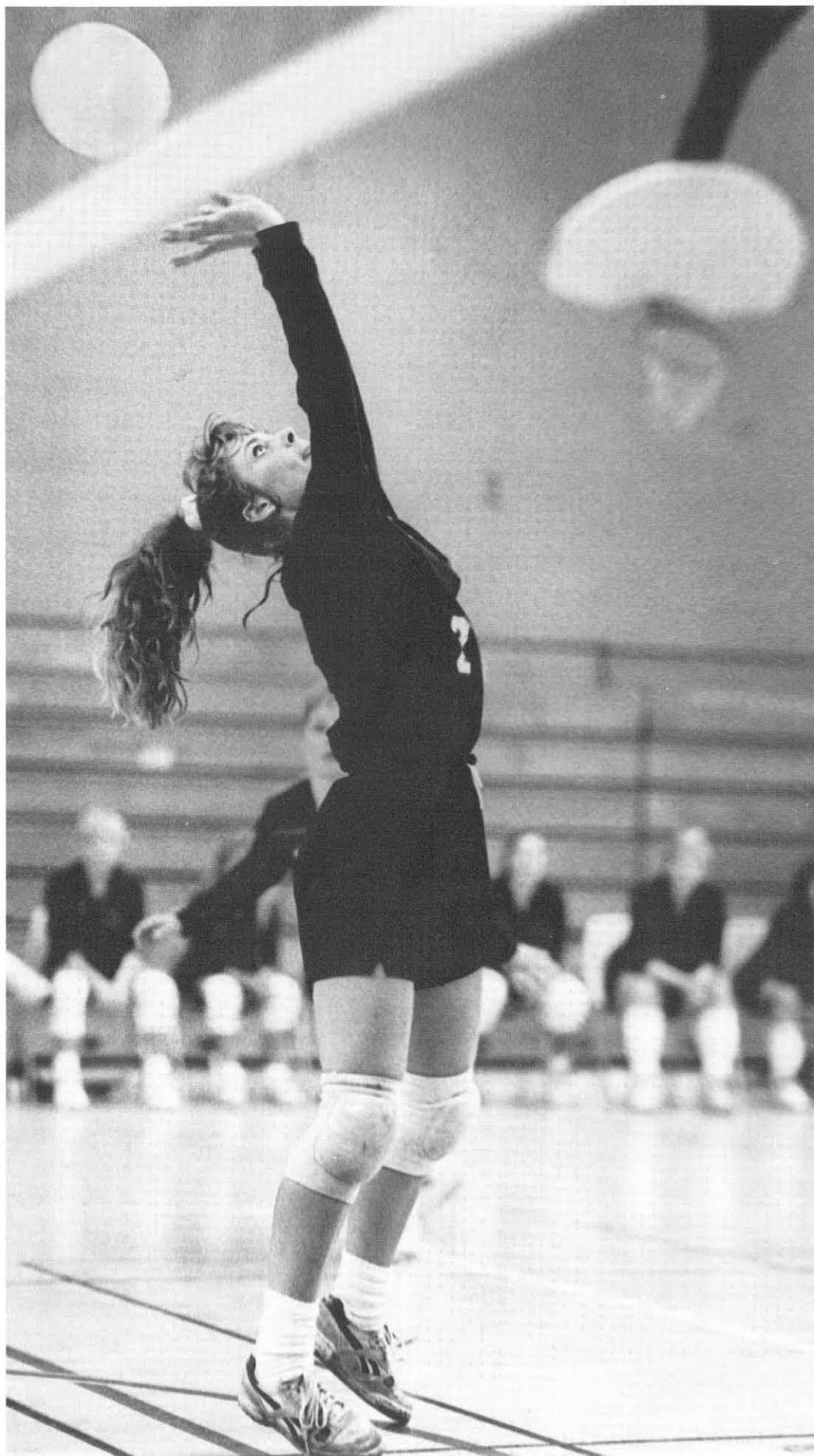
WOMEN'S VOLLEYBALL

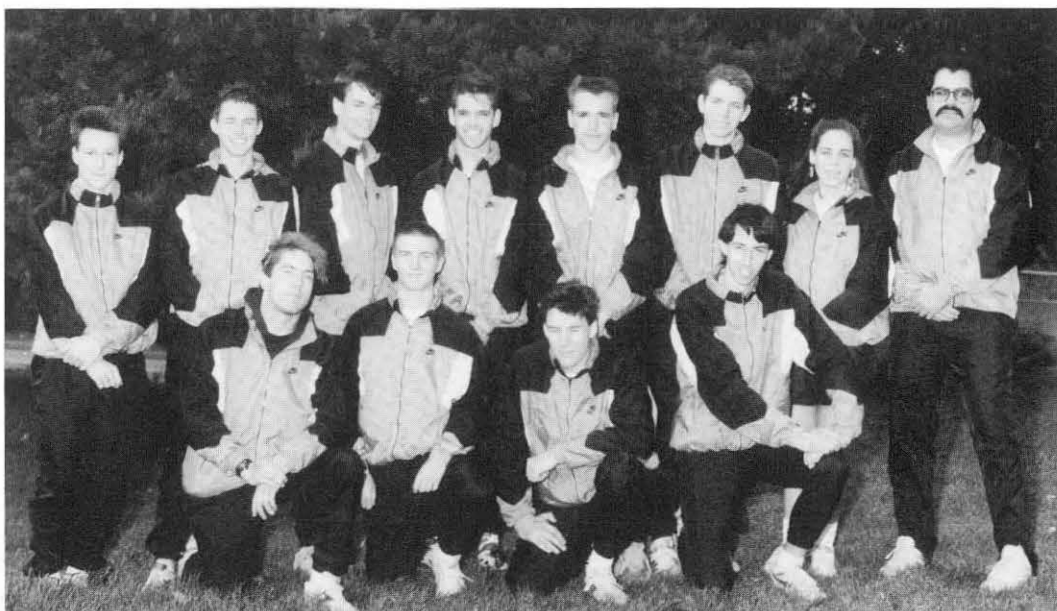

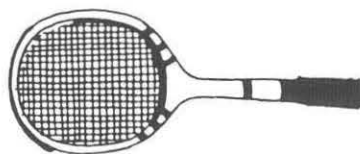

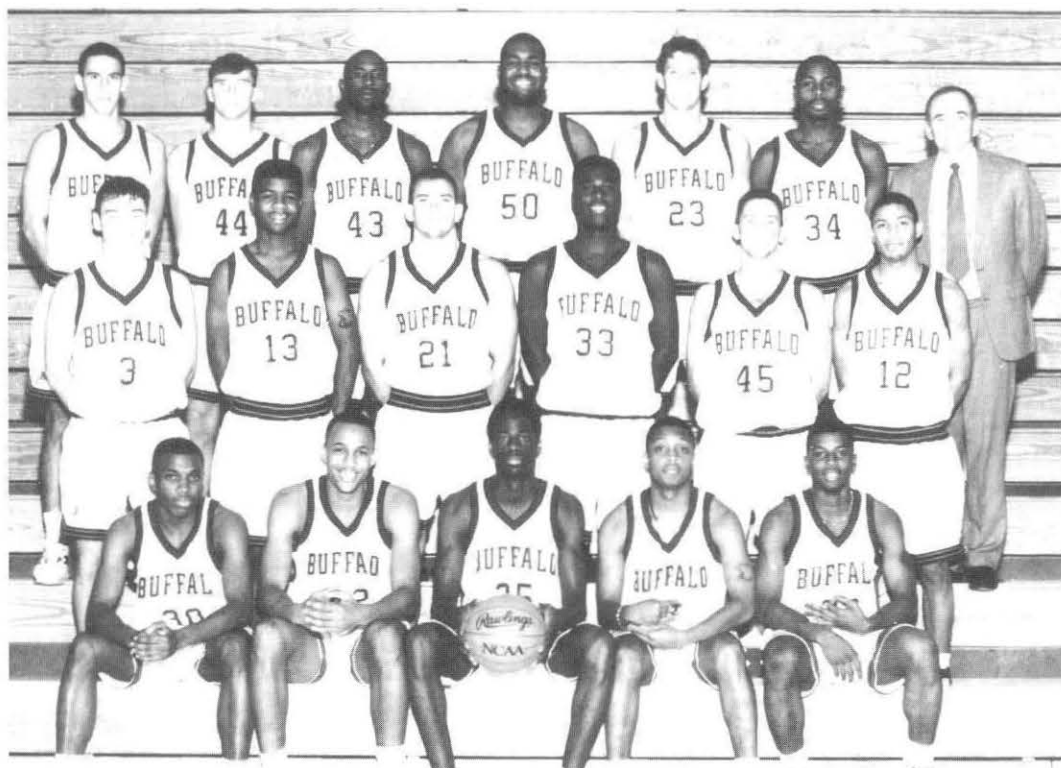


Winter MEN'S BASKETBALL

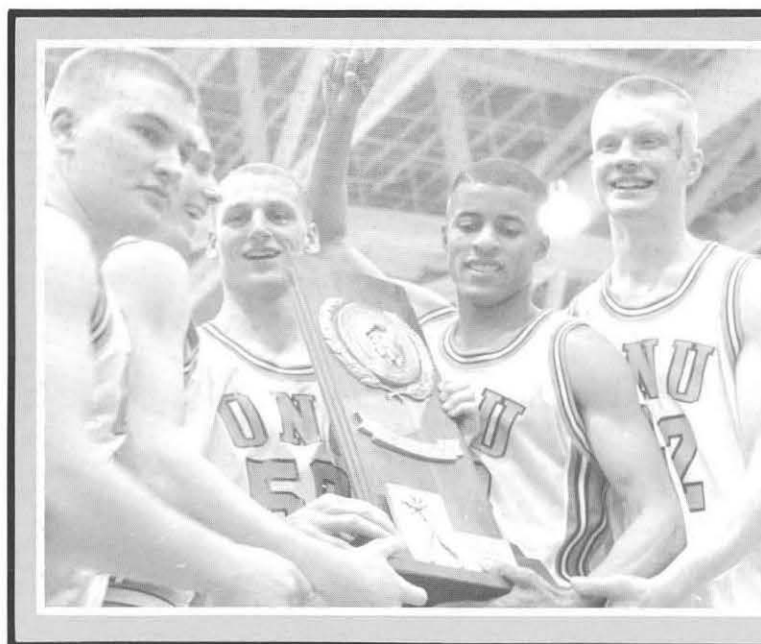

MEN'S TENNIS

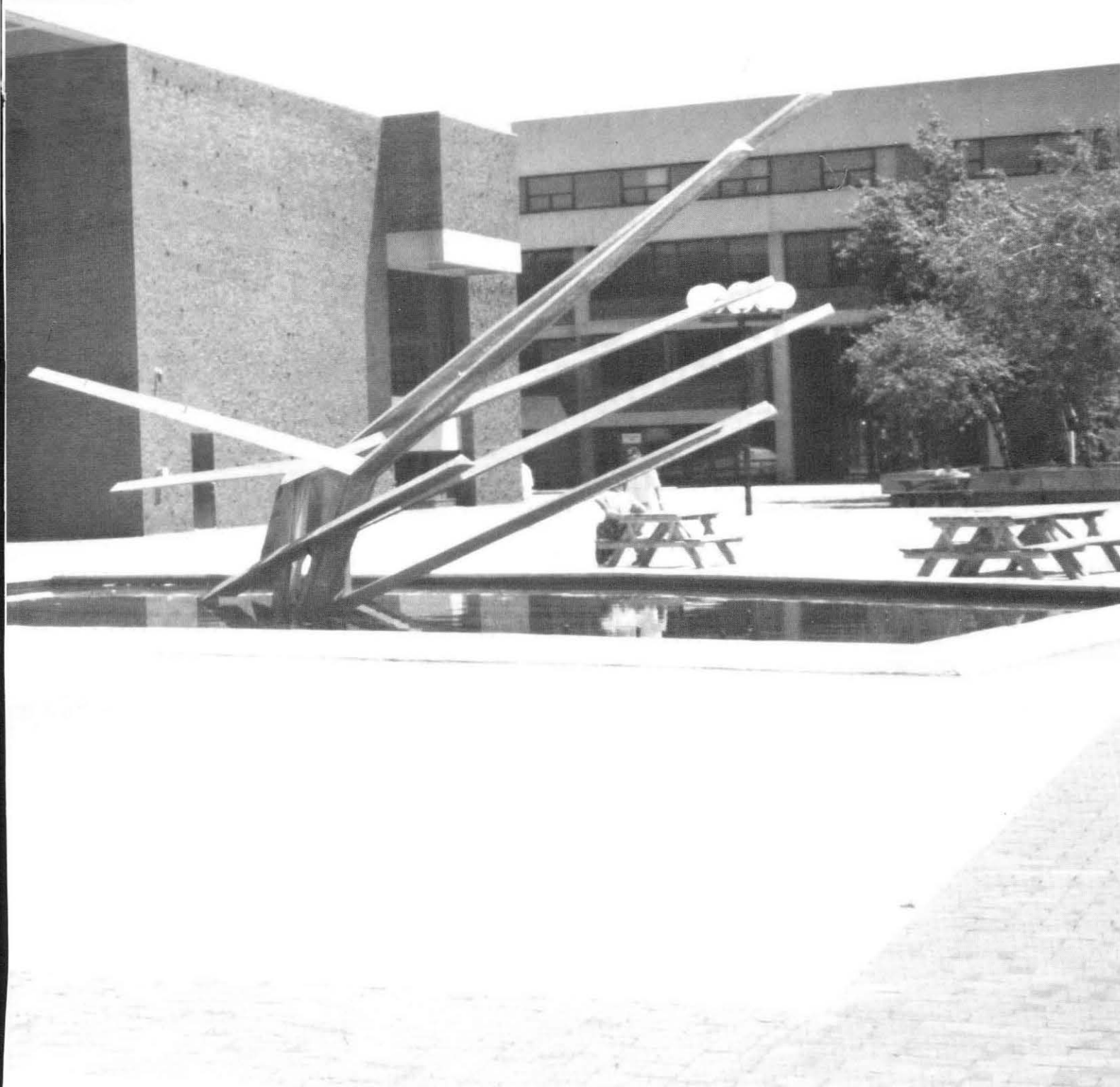
