Dear Mrs. Drzewieniecka:-

I am in receipt of your letter of the 30th September. I attempted yesterday to send your remaining parcel by airmail, and to my horror discovered that they want LP.4 for postage. Do you wish me to send it that way in spite of the expensive cost?

Your account to-date is as follows:

Carpenter work . . . . .	" 1.000
Transport . . . . .	" 1.250
Freight as per various statements enclosed	" <u>4.275</u> <u>LP. 14.025</u>

leaving a credit balance to you of . . . . . LP. 0.975

My latest report is that the boxes were forwarded on the ship EURYADES on September 16 (Bill of Lading No.MFO/EXP/766 D), which should put them in London, I assume, very shortly. I trust they arrive safely.
