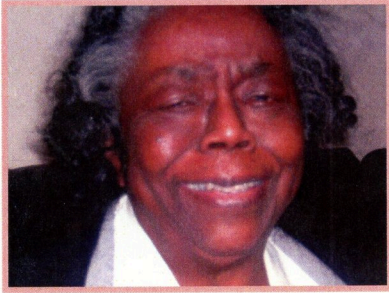

Maggie (Womack) Pugh was born May 6, 1923 in Docena, Alabama to the late Mr. and Mrs. Arthur Womack. After a brief illness, Maggie's mother Ada died when Maggie was still an infant. Her father then took Maggie to live with his cousins Jim and Emma Simmons in Union Spring, Alabama to be raised in a loving family. Maggie's father returned to Docena with

his other three children, Jimmie Lee, Ulysses and Evergreen.

Maggie was soon adopted by her caretakers and was educated at Grover High School in Union Springs. She later relocated to Buffalo New York and joined the Wesley Chapel Christian Methodist Episcopal Church.

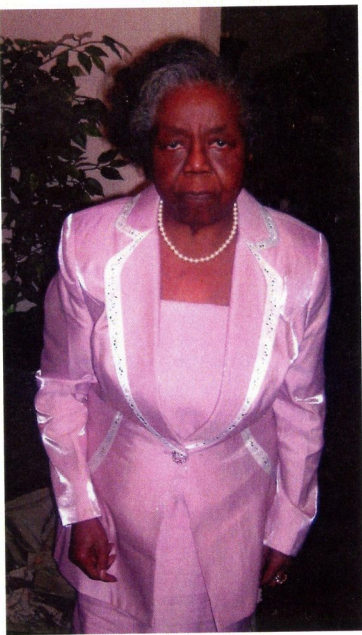
