William DuBois Leigh was born on February 13, 1931 to the late David and Vina Leigh in Tuscaloosa, Alabama. He was educated in Columbus, Mississippi public schools and attended Rust College in Holly Springs, Mississippi, where he met his future wife, Virginia Austin. Bill and Virginia were married on January 26, 1952. He traveled to Buffalo, New York in 1952 seeking employment. He held various positions prior to being hired at the Chevrolet Foundry Division of General Motors, where he worked until his retirement in 1985 as Production Superintendent of Metal Casting.

Bill joined Lincoln Memorial United Methodist Church, which became his second home. In addition to serving on numerous committees (Pastor Parish, Housekeeping, Worship, Mission and Family Outreach, Nominations and Personnel), he also served as Leader and member of both the Senior Choir and Emma J. Horner Chorale and volunteered tirelessly at Central City Cafe and the Habitat for Humanity Restore.

Bill received numerous honors for his hard work and selfless commitments: 1490 Black Achievers in Industry Award, Niagara Frontier District of the United Methodist Church laity honoree and a Habitat for Humanity Gold Key recipient.

Bill leaves cherished memories and a wondeful legacy to his wife of 54 years, Virginia; his children, Deborah (Gerald) Richardson and Michael (Holly) Leigh; his grandchildren Monique (fiance, Brian Goodwin), Rachel, Danielle and Nicole.
