Registration Instructions

PRE-REGISTRATION

All students who plan to attend anyone of the summer sessions will be given the opportunity to complete registration before the session begins. Those who take advantage of pre-registration **need not** be present on registration day.

Undergraduate students begin pre-registration in the Division Office on Monday, April 26 through Friday, May 21. IBM Student Master cards and registration packets are obtained in the Division Office. After course approval has been obtained in the Division Office go to the Summer Session Office, RH 309, next to have your name entered on class rosters.
