PRE-REGISTRATION

I. UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS ATTENDING STATE UNIVERSITY COLLEGE AT BUFFALO

Pre-registration will be held for (3) days as follows:

Tuesday,	May 14	9:00 - 12:00 noon & 1:00 - 3:00 P.M.
Wednesday,	May 15	9:00 - 12:00 noon & 1:00 - 3:00 P.M.
Thursday,	May 16	9:00 - 12:00 noon

- Obtain a registration packet and advisement at your Division Director's office on or before these dates.
- Obtain your master card in the basement of Rockwell Hall beginning May 14.
- Obtain your Class Cards in Rockwell Hall Auditorium. Complete all forms.
- Pay tuition and fees in full on the day you obtain your class cards. Class cards and all other registration cards are turned into the Bursar's station with your payment. Obtaining a class card without payment of tuition does **not** constitute registration or guarantee a seat in the course.

II. UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS ATTENDING OTHER COLLEGES

Students who are in good standing at another college may apply to be a Visiting Student during the summer. Please complete the application form below and return it to the Director of Summer Session. Pre-registration is limited to students currently attending Buffalo State. Visiting Students will receive a registration permit from the summer session office and may then register on any one of the registration dates listed in paragraph VII. Registration in the summer does not constitute admission to the college.

III. GRADUATE STUDENTS - CURRENTLY ENROLLED

Graduate students presently enrolled at the college, as well as those who were enrolled in the Summer of 1967 or the Fall semester 1967 may register, **by mail**, in our Computer Registration Program. Registration packets and instructions will be mailed on or about April 15th.

IV. NEW GRADUATE STUDENTS

New graduate students may also participate in the Computer Registration Program, if their application was received by the Graduate Office, Rockwell Hall 224, **NO LATER THAN MARCH 15**. Registration packets and instructions will also be sent to you on or about April 15. If your application was received after March 15 you may register on any registration date listed in paragraph VII.

V. CONTINUING EDUCATION STUDENTS - CURRENTLY ENROLLED

Continuing Education students (Non-matriculated) who were enrolled in courses through the Continuing Education Office may pre-register by following the instructions in paragraph I. Registration packets and advisement will be available on or after Tuesday, May 7 in Rockwell Hall 309.

VI. NEW CONTINUING EDUCATION STUDENTS

New continuing education students may pre-register for summer session if your application was received in the Continuing Education Office, Rockwell Hall 309, **NO LATER THAN MARCH 15**. Registration packets and advisement will be available in RH 309 on or after May 7. If your application was received after this date you may register on any of the regular registration dates listed in paragraph VII.

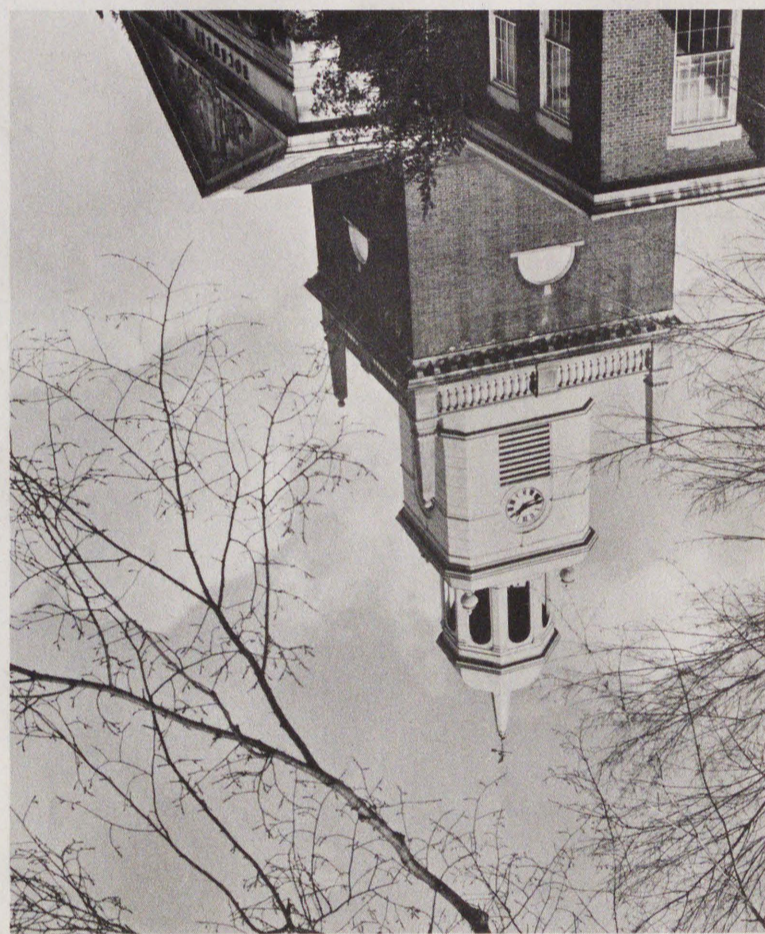
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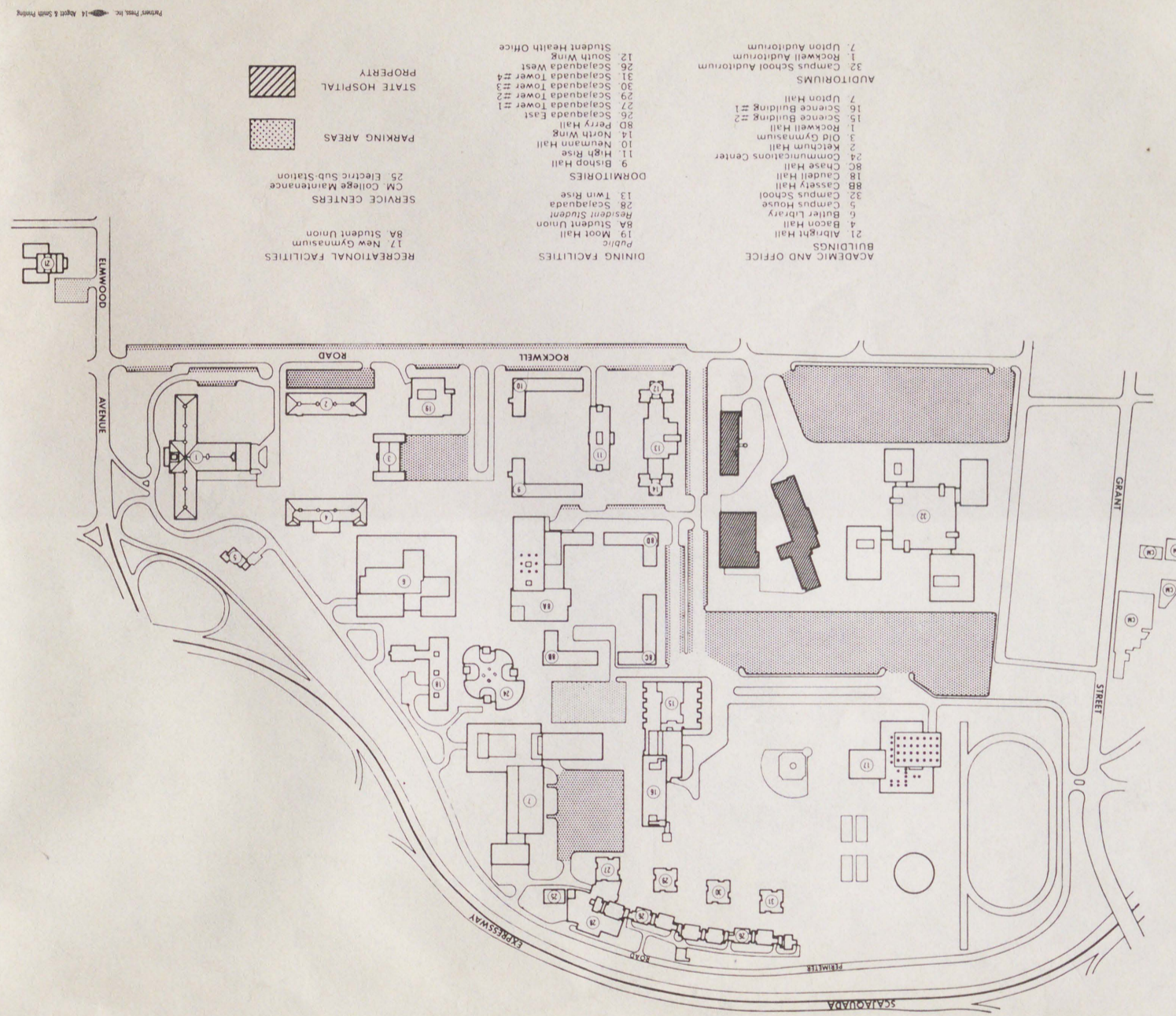
