OBITUARY

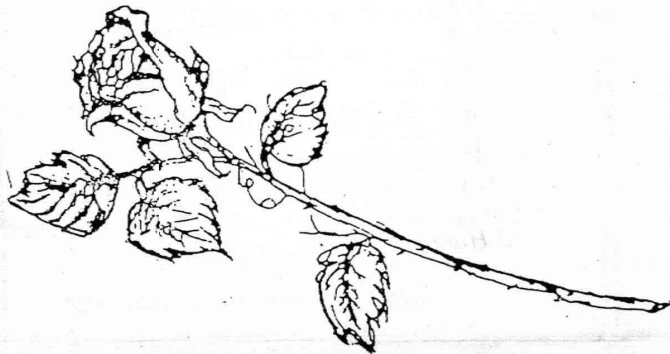
