## Obituary

Edward D. Gladden departed this life on Sunday, February 16, 1997 at Buffalo General Hospital.

He was the seventh of seventeen children born to the late Alfred and Lula Gladden, in Chester, South Carolina on February 2, 1918. Edward received Christ in his life at Mt. Hebron A.M.E. Church in Chester at an early age. After moving to Baltimore he continued his Christian Service. In 1938 he moved to Buffalo where he joined Bethel A.M.E. Church under the late Rev. D.O. Walker. He served on the Male Usher Board and was appointed to the Steward Board by the late Rev. Harry J. White Sr. There he met and married Vera E. Hoffman. They shared 44 years together.
